The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Bill Anderson, Mike Walstead, Steve Wyum, Jerry Waswick and Maurice Orn. Absent none.

Approve January 3, 2006 minutes as corrected. (Anderson/Orn, unanimous)

Damon DeVillers, Interstate Eng., Sparky Engquist, SC Road Foreman and Richard Anderson, Weed Control Officer met with the Board. Damon discussed the Project Concept Reports that have been submitted to NDDOT for the upcoming road projects. He has revised the estimates based on fuel increase costs, which have risen substantially. NDDOT is requesting a five-year plan for county secondary roads, bridges and emergency repairs. The Board of Commissioners will inspect the roadways with Sparky Engquist and Damon DeVillers on January 19 to prepare the plan. A COE 404 permit is required for the County # 1 Blended Base and Bituminous Seal Coat project. Authorize the Chairman to sign the application for the permit. Bridge 127-2.0 is awaiting approval from NDDOT and on the May 19, 2006 bid letting. A decision will be made at the February 7 meeting on whether to proceed.

Sandy Hanson joined the meeting at 10:50 a.m.

Richard Anderson discussed new equipment that was introduced at the Annual Weed Control conference last week that will identify weeds along the roadways that can be marked for weed control. This GPS system can be programmed for many different applications. Sargent County has the entire road system programmed for GIS. Some of the equipment would need updating and the maps need to be updated. Steve Wyum suggested the Technology Committee discuss whether this is a task that can be completed within the county or if additional assistance is needed. Sandy Hanson is Chairman and will call a meeting of this committee.

Sparky Engquist updated the Board on road department issues. There is a gravel school coming up and he plans to send Donald Marquette and John Meckle. The road employees are doing some shop upkeep and cleaning and completing the sign inventory. Sparky also plans to attend the 2006 NDACE Institute in Fargo February 1-3. The 1990 Cat 215D Trackhoe was totaled following an accident on 10/20/05. We have not heard from the insurance company on the settlement for Sargent County.

Jean Thielman, Project Director, Ransom-Sargent Senior Services and Brian Arett, Executive Director, Fargo Senior Commission met with the Board to discuss the programs for Sargent County. Outreach, transportation and meals are down from 2004. Funding will increase due to legislative changes. The Outreach Workers are assisting seniors in the Medicare Part D Prescription enrollment program.

Mike Manstrom, Dougherty & Co. LLC provided a handout for the General Obligation County Road Bonds for 2006 and explained the economic impact study based on a 10-year bond issue. The Board tabled any decision until February 21, 2006.

Colleen Sundquist, SC Health District Administrator, met with the Board to update them on the Employer Based Wellness Program. She explained the established timeline and the need to complete an application to receive the 1-% discount from ND PERS for health insurance premiums. Colleen will complete the application and also apply for other funding that may be available for incentives.

Sandy Hanson, Emergency Manager, met with the Board to inform them of the upcoming Red River Basin Commission meeting on February 6 in Wahpeton to continue the dialogue concerning the flooding concerns along the Wild Rice River.

Information was reviewed by the Board that US General Services Administration rates have changed for federal mileage from \$0.485 to \$0.445 as of January 1, 2006. Sargent County bases their mileage rate on 87.5% of the federal rate. Effective 1-1-06 mileage rate for employees of Sargent County will be reduced from \$0.425 to \$0.39.

Sheriff Travis Paeper arrived at the meeting and the Board questioned the vouchers for the Fraternal Order of Police. Police Commissioner Waswick and Sheriff Paeper will do some further research.

Auditor Sherry Hosford was instructed to contact State Insurance Dept. and request a \$2,000,000 Commercial Blanket Bond for Sargent County.

Instruct County Auditor to call for sealed bids in the official newspaper for furnishing supplies for the period beginning April 1, 2006 and ending March 31, 2007. Bids shall be opened March 21, 2006 as follows: Gravel-11:00 a.m.; Mixing, Laying & Drying Blacktop Surfacing-11:20 a.m.; Bituminous Materials-11:25 a.m.; 10% Blended Ethanol gasoline, Fuel, Biodiesel Blend/10% bio-diesel with 90% petroleum diesel or "B10" & LP Gas-11:30 a.m. (Walstead/Anderson, unanimous)

Approve Games of Chance Permit No. 2006-02 to Cogswell Gun Club for a raffle on February 26, 2006 at Silver Lake Park and Permit No. 2006-03 to Bergen Lutheran Cemetery Committee for a raffle on January 28, 2006 at the Geneseo Bar and Grill. (Orn/Anderson, unanimous)

Authorize removal of item nos. 1236 and 1618 from county inventory and approve disposal. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)
