THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY R. W. SAFSTROM, COUNTY AUDITOR.

THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE WAS ADMINISTERED TO THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS WHO WERE ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOV. 3RD, 1942: H. C. LOUDEN, FIRST DISTRICT; OLIVER A. RONNING, SECOND DISTRICT; AND ELMER WALSTEAD, THIRD DISTRICT.

A MOTION WAS MADE, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT THE CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR BE ELECTED BY SECRET BALLOT.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO BALLOT WITH THE RESULT THAT GEO. C. DAWSON RECEIVED A MAJORITY, AND HE WAS OFFICIALLY DECLARED CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD FOR THE YEAR 1943.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

COMMISSIONER SAEWERT MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER OF BUSINESS BE ADOPTED FOR THE ENSUING YEAR: FIRST, ROLL CALL; SECOND, READING OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING, THIRD, APPROVING OF PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD BILLS; FOURTH, UNFINISHED BUSINESS; FIFTH, APPLICATIONS AND PETITIONS; SIXTH, BILLS; SEVENTH, MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS; EIGHT, ADJOURNMENT.

COMMISSIONER RONNING SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER LOUDEN THAT MR. SAEWERT BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER LOUDEN THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE OTHER COMMISSIONERS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY.

COMMISSIONER SAEWERT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER LOUDEN, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER SAEWERT AND CARRIED, THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITORS WARRANTS, ALL SALARIES AND CLERK HIRE AND JANITORS SALARIES FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1943, AS FIXED BY THE BOARD OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT, ALSO ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE COUNTY PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALSO ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE STATE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF NORTH DAKOTA AND THE RURAL REHABILITATION CORPORATION OR ITS SUCCESSORS AND SARGENT COUNTY OF COLLECTIONS MADE FOR LIVESTOCK FEED ASSISTANCE LOANS.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT F. G. HUBBARD, M. D., BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER RONNING SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER LOUDEN MOVED THAT THE SALARY OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR BE FIXED AT \$300.00, SAME BEING THE MINIMUM AMOUNT THAT THE LAW ALLOWS, AND THAT THE MILEAGE BE FIXED AT 5 CENTS PER MILE NECESSARILY TRAVELED.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF INSANITY COMMISSIONER.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD THAT A. LESLIE BE APPOINTED INSANITY COMMISSIONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS.

COMMISSIONER LOUDEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER RONNING THAT J. H. HOHAUS BE APPOINTED COUNTY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS.
COMMISSIONER LOUDEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER SAEWERT, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD, THAT LOUIS STEIMKE BE APPOINTED COUNTY CORONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS.
MOTION CARRIED.

THE RESIGNATION OF OBED A. WYUM, AS MEMBER OF THE COUNTY PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE RESIGNATION OF MR. WYUM BE ACCEPTED.
COMMISSIONER LOUDEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.
