FORMAN, N. DAK. JANUARY 5, 1949.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY R. W. SAFSTROM, COUNTY AUDITOR, AND PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE WAS ADMINISTERED TO THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS WHO WERE ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 2, 1948:

HARRY KIEFER, 1ST DISTRICT; D. D. MARQUETTE, 2ND DISTRICT; GEO. C. DAWSON, 4TH DISTRICT AND GLENN B. COLEMAN, 5TH DISTRICT.

THE BOARD THEN PROCEEDED TO ELECT CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

GEO. C. DAWSON AND ELMER WALSTEAD WERE NOMINATED. IT WAS AGREED TO VOTE BY SECRET BALLOT, AND ON THE FIRST BALLOT ELMER WALSTEAD RECEIVED A MAJORITY AND HE WAS OFFICIALLY DECLARED CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1949.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-1136, 1943 CODE, BE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE THAT ELMER WALSTEAD BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE OTHER COMMISSIONERS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY.

COMMISSIONER KIEFER SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITORS WARRANTS, ALL SALARIES AND CLERK HIRE AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1949, OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT; ALSO ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE COUNTY PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALSO ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE STATE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF NORTH DAKOTA AND THE RURAL REHABILITATION CORPORATION OR ITS SUCCESSORS AND SARGENT COUNTY OF COLLECTIONS MADE FOR LIVESTOCK FEED ASSISTANCE LOANS; BILLS FOR LIGHT AND POWER AND INCOME AND SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES WITHHELD ON WAGES, TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES AND SALARY AND EXPENSES OF GOVERNMENT HUNTER. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT DR. F. G. HUBBARD BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SARGENT COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON THAT THE SALARY OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BE FIXED AT \$300.00 FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF INSANITY COMMISSIONER.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON THAT WALTER C. KING BE APPOINTED INSANITY COMMISSIONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS.

COMMISSIONER KIEFER SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE COUNTY AUDITOR REPORTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN FILED IN HIS OFFICE, THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS, ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOV. 2, 1948, AND THAT HE HAD ON FILE CERTIFICATIONS FROM THE STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT THAT SAID OFFICERS HAD BEEN DULY BONDED BY THE SAID STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW:

ON MOTION THE BOARD ALLOWED THE APPLICATION OF JONAS BJORK FOR ABATEMENT OF \$2.00 SCHOOL POLL IN DUNBAR TOWNSHIP, FOR THE REASON THAT HE HAD BEEN ASSESSED AND PAID THE SAME \$2.00 SCHOOL POLL IN TOWN OF FORMAN.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION, AND, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE, MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS, THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT CONTEMPLATES THE IMPROVEMENT OR CONSTRUCTION OF A PART OF ITS HIGHWAY SYSTEM WITHIN THIS COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH WHAT IS KNOWN AS HIGHWAY PROJECT F 147(2) SARGENT COUNTY, AND SUCH IMPROVEMENT OR CONSTRUCTION WILL REQUIRE THE ACQUISITION BY THE STATE OF LANDS FOR RIGHT OF WAY OR BORROW PITS WITHIN THIS COUNTY,

"BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT THIS COUNTY PAY FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE ACTUAL COST OF SUCH LANDS, WHETHER ACQUIRED BY CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS OR BY DIRECT PURCHASES FROM THE OWNERS OF THE SAME, INCLUDING SUCH SUMS AS MAY BE PAID AND ALLOWED SUCH OWNERS ON ACCOUNT OF DAMAGES TO IMPROVEMENTS, REMOVAL OF IMPROVEMENTS OR OTHER ALLOWABLE DAMAGES UNDER THE LAW OF EMINENT DOMAIN OF THIS STATE, INCLUDING LANDS ACQUIRED BY PURCHASE AT WHAT IS DEEMED A REASONABLE VALUATION BY THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT IF SAID LANDS TO BE ACQUIRED FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES ARE ACQUIRED BY THIS COUNTY OR ITS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE STATE, AND PAID FOR WITH COUNTY FUNDS, THE COUNTY AUDITOR SHALL PRESENT AS SOON AS CONVENIENTLY MAY BE AFTER SUCH PAYMENT, TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, PROPER VOUCHER FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THIS COUNTY OF FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE COUNTY FUNDS SO EXPENDED THEREFOR; AND, IF SAID LANDS OR ANY OF THEM ARE ACQUIRED AND PAID FOR BY THE STATE, OR ITS STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT OUT OF STATE FUNDS, THEN THE COUNTY AUDITOR UPON PRESENTATION TO HIM OF A VOUCHER DULY CERTIFIED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ENGINEER OF SAID STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, SHALL, AND HE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO DRAW AND DELIVER TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DUE AND PROPER COUNTY WARRANT OF THIS COUNTY FOR FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE ACTUAL TOTAL COST OF SAID LANDS SO PAID FOR BY THE STATE OR ITS STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

ON ROLL CALL ALL MEMBERS PRESENT VOTED IN FAVOR OF SAID RESOLUTION, AND THE SAME WAS DECLARED DULY CARRIED AND ADOPTED.
