

FORMAN, N. DAK. JAN. 7, 1958.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

THE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY R. W. SAFSTROM, COUNTY AUDITOR, AND PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT G. B. COLEMAN BE ELECTED CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD IN DECEMBER WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE MOVED THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-1136, 1943 REVISED CODE, BE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD. COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SMITH THAT MR. WALSTEAD BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER HOFLEN THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE COMMISSIONERS FROM OTHER DISTRICTS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY. COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE MOVED THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITOR'S WARRANTS THE FOLLOWING:

ALL SALARIES, INCLUDING JANITORS, AND CLERK HIRE AND THE SALARY AND EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT PREDATORY MAMMAL CONTROL AGENT, AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1958, OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT.

ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND.

ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE STATE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF NORTH DAKOTA AND THE RURAL REHABILITATION CORPORATION OR ITS SUCCESSORS AND SARGENT COUNTY FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE SHARES OF COLLECTIONS MADE FOR LIVESTOCK FEED ASSISTANCE LOANS.

ALL CLAIMS FOR TELEPHONE, LIGHT AND POWER AND ALL WITHHOLDING AND SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES WITHHELD OUT OF WAGES, TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES, AND ALL ESTIMATES ISSUED TO CONTRACTORS FOR ROAD WORK, AS CERTIFIED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE MOVED THAT DR. F. G. HUBBARD BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SARGENT COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AND HIS SALARY BE FIXED AT \$300.00, AND MILEAGE AS PROVIDED BY LAW. COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INSANITY COMMISSIONER.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT ROBERT A. CABE BE APPOINTED INSANITY COMMISSIONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE BOARD MEET AT 2 O'CLOCK, P.M. JAN. 21, 1958, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DESIGNATING DEPOSITORIES OF PUBLIC FUNDS, AND THAT THE AUDITOR BE INSTRUCTED TO NOTIFY THE BANKS IN THE COUNTY AS PROVIDED BY LAW. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE REPORT OF SHERIFF MILTON FAY OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED DURING THE MONTH OF DECEMBER BE APPROVED IN THE SUM OF \$6,055.20. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE.

THE BOARD HAD, DURING THE DAY, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE SHERIFF, BEEN EXAMINING THE DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RECORDS, AND HAD CANCELLED SUCH TAXES AS WERE, IN THE OPINION OF THE BOARD, UNCOLLECTIBLE AND NOW PROCEEDED TO REVIEW SAID CANCELLATION WHICH HAD BEEN MADE WHERE THE TAX WAS FOUND UNCOLLECTIBLE THROUGH DEATH OF OWNER, REMOVAL FROM THE COUNTY OR FOR THE REASON THAT THE PROPERTY HAD BEEN LOST BY LEGAL PROCESS OR ACQUIRED BY THE GOVERNMENT, OR FOR OTHER VALID REASONS, SAID CANCELLATIONS BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 57-2211, 1943 REVISED CODE.





