THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET IN SPECIAL SESSION, PURSUANT TO CALL BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ATTENDING TO HIGHWAY MATTERS AND ANY OTHER BUSINESS THAT MIGHT BE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD. ALL MEMBERS WERE PRESENT.

ENTER

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY INTO THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARD SECURING COOPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY ACT OF 1944, OR OTHER SUBSEQUENT FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY ACTS, WHICH AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CONTINUING THE CONSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS ON THE COUNTY FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY SYSTEM, FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECTS NOB. CS 483 (2) - GRADE ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13, 1.5 MILES NW OF STIRUM NORTH AND CS 848 (1) - GRADE ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13, 2 MILES NORTH OF ORETE, NORTH TO COUNTY LINE.

2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COST EXCEPT THE AMOUNTY PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND, IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENT IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY TO THE CONTRACTOR OR ANY OTHER PARTIES WHICH ARE LATER FOUND NON COLLECTABLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED. THE TERM "CONSTRUCTION" MEANS THE SUPERVISING, INSPECTING, ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION OR RECONSTRUCTION OF THE HIGHWAY INCLUDING LOCATING, SURVEYING, MAPPING, COSTS OF RIGHT OF WAYS, COST OF ADVERTISING AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATION.

3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO MAKE BINDING AND A PART OF THIS AGREEMENT ALL PROVISION OF RESOLUTIONS EXECUTED BY THE COUNTY AFFECTING THIS PROJECT OR RELATING TO THE MAINTENANCE OF ANY PORTION OF THE COUNTY'S FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY SYSTEM.

4. THE COUNTY WILL, AT ITS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL-AID REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS OF WAY.

5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTING SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE COUNTY, TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL-AID EARNED.

6. REQUIRE TESTS OF ALL MATERIALS ENTERING INTO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT, SHALL BE MADE BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT TESTING LABORATORY. IT IS THE COUNTY'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF SAMPLES ARE TAKEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR TESTING.

7. FEDERAL FUNDS WILL ONLY PARTICIPATE IN WORK PERFORMED SUBSEQUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.

8. AN ENGINEERING AND CLERICAL CHARGE OF 1% OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT WILL BE MADE BY THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WHICH THE COUNTY AGREES TO PAY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT  
COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE BOARD ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA HERINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HERINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT HEREBY AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 3,932 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY - GRADE ON COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13, 1.5 MILES NW OF STIRUM NORTH AND 4.266 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY - GRADE COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13, 2 MILES NORTH OF CRETE, NORTH TO COUNTY LINE, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECTS NOS. CS 483 (2) AND CS 848 (1) RESPECTIVELY, AND WILL RECOMMEND ITS APPROVAL BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH FUNDS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE UNDER THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED: SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE CONDITION THAT THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER MAINTENANCE AFTER COMPLETION OF ITS IMPROVEMENT.

2. THAT THE SAID COUNTY HEREBY REQUESTS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT THE AFOREMENTIONED PROJECTS WITH RECOMMENDATION THAT IT BE APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND AGREES THAT IF SUCH PROJECT IS APPROVED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IT THEREAFTER, AT ITS OWN EXPENSE WILL MAINTAIN THE PROJECT IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY TO THEM, OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, AND WILL MAKE AMPLE PROVISION EACH YEAR FOR SUCH MAINTENANCE.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

DUAINE L. DODDS MET WITH THE COMMISSIONERS AND SUBMITTED HIS RESIGNATION AS COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE BOARD ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF DUAIN L. DODDS AS COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>, 1960.

COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE COUNTY DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX LISTS, WHICH WILL BE PUBLISHED IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE COUNTY, IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 57-2202 OF THE 1959 SESSION LAWS, ALSO BE PUBLISHED IN THE SARGENT COUNTY TELLER ACCORDING TO PROVISIONS OF SECTION 46-0503 OF THE 1943 REVISED CODE AS AMENDED BY THE 1959 SESSION LAWS.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE INSTRUCTED TO PUBLISH IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER, CALLING FOR SEALED BIDS FOR THE FURNISHING OF THE FOLLOWING FOR THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR THE ENSUING YEAR: RENTAL OF HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT, SCREENING, LOADING, CRUSHING, HAULING GRAVEL, DRAGLINE AND OPERATOR, RENTAL OF WATER TANK AND PACKER, BIDS TO BE OPENED AT 2 O'CLOCK P.M. MARCH 1ST, 1960.

COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET IN SPECIAL SESSION, PURSUANT TO CALL BY THE CHAIRMAN, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

A DELEGATION CONSISTING OF J.W. HARING SR., LEONARD BOPP SR., OLE BREUM, HAROLD JELLEBERG, KENNETH BREEZE, DUAIN L. DODDS, MURDEEN GULRVIG, EARL ROBINSON AND HARLAN KLEFSTAD MET WITH THE COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECLARING SARGENT COUNTY A DISASTER AREA. AFTER CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION IT WAS DECIDED TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR SAME.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION, AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ENGE, MOVED ITS ADOPTION: WHEREAS, IT IS NECESSARY THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REQUEST AND APPROVE REVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY COUNTY SYSTEM WITHIN THE COUNTY, AND

WHEREAS, IT IS DEEMED ADVISABLE TO CHANGE FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY ROUTES NOS. 282, 600 AND 974, BE IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT THIS COUNTY REQUESTS AND APPROVES THE REVISION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED ROUTES AS FOLLOWS: No. 282,

EXTEND FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10, TWP. 129 N., RANGE 53 W. L.T.L. SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 3.0 MILES TO THE NORTH DAKOTA - SOUTH DAKOTA STATE LINE.

No. 600,  
EXTEND FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 11, TWP. 129 N., RANGE 58 W., SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 5.0 MILES TO THE NORTH DAKOTA - SOUTH DAKOTA STATE LINE.

No. 974,  
EXTEND FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19, TWP. 129 N. RANGE 53 W. L.T.L., SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 0.8 MILES TO THE NORTH DAKOTA - SOUTH DAKOTA STATE LINE.

ON ROLL CALL A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT VOTED IN FAVOR OF SAID RESOLUTION, AND THE SAME WAS DECLARED DULY CARRIED AND ADOPTED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT A CERTAIN MORTGAGE EXECUTED BY LOUIS AND MINNIE DEBOER OF COGSWELL, N. DAK. TO SARGENT COUNTY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION ON THE 8TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1939, UPON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY LOCATED IN SARGENT COUNTY, N. DAK. TO-WIT: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  AND NW $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SECTION 30, TWP. 131, RANGE 57, IS ENTITLED TO BE DISCHARGED AND SATISFIED BY REASON OF PAYMENT AND THAT THE CHAIRMAN AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE INSTRUCTED TO DISCHARGE SAME OF RECORD. COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE BOARD ADJOURN, COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE PETITION RECEIVED FROM TEWAUKON TOWNSHIP BE TABLED UNTIL THE LOCATION OF THE ROAD REQUESTED HAS DEFINITELY BEEN DECIDED.

COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

JAMES KENWARD MET WITH THE BOARD AND SUBMITTED HIS APPLICATION FOR THE POSITION OF COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT JAMES KENWARD BE HIRED AS COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT FOR SARGENT COUNTY, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 16TH, 1960.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

HOWARD OLSON MET WITH THE COMMISSIONERS IN REGARDS TO PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, THE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 19,675.00 OF OSCAR BLUMER RECEIVED IN THE LETTING OF JANUARY 29TH, 1960, FOR PROJECT CS 848 (1) WAS THE LOW BID RECEIVED.

WHEREAS, THIS BID IS CONSIDERED REASONABLE AND IS UNDER THE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT COUNTY, THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT BE REQUESTED TO AWARD TO THE OSCAR BLUMER THE CONTRACT FOR PROJECT CS 848 (1) AND SECURE FEDERAL CONCURRENCE THEREOF.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD THAT THE COUNTY SHALL REIMBURSE THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR ANY PAYMENTS MADE UNDER THIS CONTRACT, WHICH ARE NOT COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS.

COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE RESOLUTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MR. ANDERSON AND MR. THORNBERG, REPRESENTING THE ST. PAUL FIRE & MARINE INSURANCE CO., SUBMITTED A PROPOSAL FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR SARGENT COUNTY. AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION, IT WAS DECIDED TO TABLE PROPOSAL FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, THE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 15,423.23 OF DONALD BURNSTAD RECEIVED IN THE LETTING OF JANUARY 29TH, 1960, FOR PROJECT CS 483 (2) WAS THE LOW BID RECEIVED.

WHEREAS, THIS BID IS CONSIDERED REASONABLE AND IS UNDER THE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT COUNTY, THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT BE REQUESTED TO AWARD TO THE DONALD BURNSTAD THE CONTRACT FOR PROJECT CS 483 (2) AND SECURE FEDERAL CONCURRENCE THEREOF.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD THAT THE COUNTY SHALL REIMBURSE THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR ANY PAYMENTS MADE UNDER THIS CONTRACT, WHICH ARE NOT COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS.

COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE RESOLUTION AND SAME CARRIED.
