

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY RALPH SEAVERT, COUNTY AUDITOR, AND THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT COMMISSIONER SMITH BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED. ALL COMMISSIONERS VOTING "AYE".

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED AS READ.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-11-36 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE BE ADOPTED AND THAT COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AND THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD & BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE COMMISSIONERS FROM OTHER DISTRICTS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY, AND THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITOR'S WARRANTS THE FOLLOWING: ALL SALARIES, INCLUDING JANITORS AND CLERK HIRE AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1ST, 1962, OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT, ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE PUBLIC WELFARE TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALL BILLS FOR TELEPHONE, LIGHT AND POWER AND ALL WITHHOLDING AND SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES WITHHELD OUT OF WAGES TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER BE GIVEN AUTHORITY TO DESTROY ALL UNUSED 1960 TAX RECEIPTS. COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE APPLICATION OF CLAYTON SEVERSON TO SELL BEER "ON & OFF SALE" ON LOT 5, BLOCK 2, VILLAGE OF DELAMERE, BE APPROVED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE APPLICATION OF CLARA MCMAHON FOR ABATEMENT OF SCHOOL POLL IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP, BE APPROVED FOR THE REASON THAT APPLICANT HAD BEEN ASSESSED SCHOOL POLL IN VERNER TOWNSHIP.







COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT: THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HERINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HERINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARD SECURING COOPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN TITLE 23 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED AND AUTHORIZATIONS PROVIDED PURSUANT THERETO AND AVAILABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECT NOS. CS 211 (5), CS 217 (6) AND CS 485 (3) GRADE, BASE BIT. SURF. TR. - Co ROAD FROM RUTLAND NORTH, AT CAYUGA AND MILNOR NORTH.

2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COSTS EXCEPT THE AMOUNT (NOT TO EXCEED 50%) PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, AND, IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENTS IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY WHICH ARE LATER FOUND NON-COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED.

THE TERM " CONSTRUCTION COSTS " SHALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION SUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTISING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING, COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEREOF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.

4. THE COUNTY WILL, AT ITS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE COUNTY, TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL-AID EARNED.

6.
