THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT COMMISSIONER DEWEY.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING SALE OF COUNTY TAX DEED PROPERTY BE APPROVED AND DEED ISSUED TO PURCHASER: $\frac{1}{2}$ OF LOTS 5-6-7, BLOCK 2, COOPER'S ADDITION, VILLAGE OF RUTLAND TO FRED CHRISTENSEN, RUTLAND, NORTH DAKOTA FOR THE SUM OF \$25.00.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION TO SELL HARD LIQUOR "ON & OFF SALE" BE APPROVED: HAROLD WABWICK ON LOT 2, BLOCK 2, RANDALL'S ADDITION, VILLAGE OF STIRUM FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1ST, 1964 AND ENDING JUNE 30TH, 1964.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

The Board of County Commissioners met, pursuant to adjournment, with all members present except Commissioner Coleman.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion approved as read.

The meeting was called to order by Ralph Seavert, County Auditor and the Board proceeded to organize for the ensuing year.

Commissioner Smith moved that Palmer Enge be appointed to serve as Chairman for the ensuing year.

Commissioner Dewey seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Smith moved that the order of business for the ensuing year, as provided by Chapter 11-11-36 of the North Dakota Century Code be adopted and that Commissioner Dewey be appointed to serve as Courthouse Commissioner for the ensuing year, and that each Commissioner be appointed to serve as Road & Bridge Commissioner in and for his own district, with power to call to his assistance Commissioners from other districts to act with him when necessary, and that the County Auditor be authorized and directed to pay by Auditor's Warrants the following: All salaries, including janitors, Civil Defense Director and clerk hire as fixed by the Board and approved in the various budget requests for the fiscal year, or by legislative enactment, all orders presented by the Public Welfare Board to be paid out of the Social Welfare Fund, all bills for telephone, light and power, and all withholding and Social Security taxes withheld out of wages to the proper authorities.

Commissioner Hoflen seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Smith moved that Donald J. Feist M.D. be appointed Superintendent of the Board of Health of Sargent County for the ensuing year, salary to be \$300.00 per year plus mileage as prescribed by law.

Commissioner Hoflen seconded the motion and same carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hoflen and seconded by Commissioner Dewey that Robert A. Case be re-appointed to the Sargent County Mental Health Board. Term ending January 1st, 1966. Motion Carried.

Commissioner Dewey moved that the 1963 personal property tax of Selmer Saunders in the Village of Cayuga for the sum of \$2.62 be cancelled for the reason that Mr. Saunders was also assessed in the Village of Havana for 1963.

Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Dewey moved that the County Treasurer be given authority to destroy all unused 1962 tax receipts.
Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and same carried.

The Board proceeded to open sealed proposals for the deposit of Public Funds. Proposals were submitted by the Sargent County Bank of Forman, First National Bank of Milnor and the Bank of North Dakota, Bismarck.

Commissioner Hoflen moved that the Sargent County Bank of Forman, The First National Bank of Milnor and the Bank of North Dakota of Bismarck be designated as legal depositories of County Funds for the years 1964 and 1965. Commissioner Dewey seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Dewey moved that the Public Depository agreement, for pledge of assets as security for County Funds in the Sargent County Bank of Forman covering \$50,000.00 U.S. Treasury Notes Series B1966 - 3 5/8 % # 19295/99 @ 10 M each, due 2/15/66 and \$50,000.00, the Chase Manhattan Bank, N.Y. receipt for The Twelve Federal Land Banks - 4 1/4 % Cons. Fed. Farm Loan Bonds, # 2215/9 @ 10 M each due 7/20/66 with the Northwestern National Bank of Minneapolis, Minn as Custodian and the First National Bank of Milnor covering U.S. Treasury Bonds of 1967 - 3 5/8 % due 11/15/67 in the amount of \$25,000.00 and U.S. Treasury Bonds of 1980 - 4 % due 2/15/80 in the amount of \$25,000.00 with the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, as custodian, be approved as to sufficiency according to law.

Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and same carried.

The Board next proceeded to consider bids for the furnishing of coal supplies for the ensuing year, which had been opened December 3rd, 1963 and tabled to January 7th, 1964.

Commissioner Smith moved that the bid of Leach Lumber Co. of Havana for the furnishing of coal supplies for the ensuing year be accepted.

On motion the Board approved payments made by the Sargent County Welfare Board in the sum of \$1,603.25 for the month of December and for which Warrant Nos. 7986 to 8000, 7251 to 7253 and 7308 to 7314 inclusive had been issued.

Commissioner Hoflen introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Chapter 57-22-21 of the North Dakota Century Code provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall at its January meeting, declare by resolution that all unpaid and uncollected Personal Property taxes shall constitute a lien on any real estate owned by the tax debtor, from and after the date of extension and entry thereof by the County Auditor upon the tax list of the next proceeding year, opposite the descriptions of Real Estate designated by the Board of County Commissioners, belonging to any person, Company or Corporation owing such uncollected Personal Property taxes, the year or years for which/remains due and the principal sum of such tax; and that such entry shall be made without regards to any prior payment of real estate taxes on said descriptions for the preceding year, and the County Treasurer shall be without authority thereafter to issue any receipt in full for said real estate taxes without making collection at the same time of the personal property taxes so extended; a taxpayer holding specific lien on said descriptions ahead of personal property taxes charged thereon shall be entitled to a tax receipt without regards to non-payment of such inferior personal property taxes, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that all unpaid and uncollected delinquent personal property taxes from and after the date of extension and entry thereof as provided in the foregoing minutes, shall constitute a lien on any real estate owned by the tax delinquent, or which may thereafter be acquired by the tax delinquent, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following personal property taxes owed shall be a specific lien upon property described as follows:

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT COMMISSIONER COLEMAN.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED AS READ.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARD SECURING CO-OPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN TITLE 23 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED AND AUTHORIZATIONS PROVIDED PURSUANT THERETO AND AVAILABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECT NO. CS 404(3) BASE, BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL NORTH - 4.014 MILES.

2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COSTS EXCEPT THE AMOUNT PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT (NOT TO EXCEED 50%) THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, AND, IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENTS IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY WHICH ARE LATER FOUND NON-COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED.

THE TERM "CONSTRUCTION COST" SHALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION SUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTISING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING, COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. FURTHER, THE COUNTY HEREBY CONCURS THAT THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT ADOPTED STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, DESIGN STANDARDS AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS AS RECOMMENDED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE DEPARTMENT.

3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEREOF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.

4. THE COUNTY WILL AT ITS OWN EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL-AID REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT FOR THE COUNTY TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL-AID EARNED.

6. IT IS AGREED THAT THE COUNTY SHALL HAVE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF SAMPLES ARE TAKEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR TESTING BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT'S TESTING LABORATORY AT BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA OF ALL MATERIALS TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND SIMILARLY FOR THOSE RECORD TESTS OF THE COMPLETED PROJECT AS REQUIRED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OR ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES AND THE DEPARTMENT.

7. FEDERAL FUNDS WILL ONLY PARTICIPATE IN WORK PERFORMED SUBSEQUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.

8. AN ENGINEERING AND CLERICAL CHARGE OF 1% OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT WILL BE MADE BY THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WHICH THE COUNTY AGREES TO PAY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT, AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF SARGENT COUNTY ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL SUBMIT A PROJECT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 4,014 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL NORTH - BASE, BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT NO. CS 404(3), AND WILL RECOMMEND ITS APPROVAL BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH FUNDS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE UNDER THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED; SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE CONDITION THAT THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER MAINTENANCE AFTER COMPLETION OF ITS IMPROVEMENT.

2. THAT THE SAID COUNTY HEREBY REQUESTS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT THE AFOREMENTIONED PROJECT WITH RECOMMENDATION THAT IT BE APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND AGREES THAT IF SUCH PROJECT IS APPROVED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IT THEREAFTER, AT ITS OWN COST AND EXPENSE, WILL MAINTAIN THE PROJECT IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY TO THEM, OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, AND WILL MAKE AMPLE PROVISION EACH YEAR FOR SUCH MAINTENANCE, AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF SARGENT COUNTY ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.
