JANUARY 4TH, 1966

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY RALPH SEAVERT, COUNTY AUDITOR, AND THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT COMMISSIONER ENGE BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED AS READ.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-11-36 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE BE ADOPTED AND THAT COMMISSIONER DEWEY BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AND THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS ROAD & BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE COMMISSIONERS FROM OTHER DISTRICTS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY, AND THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITOR'S WARRANTS THE FOLLOWING: ALL SALARIES, INCLUDING JANITORS, CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR AND CLERK HIRE AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT, ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALL BILLS FOR TELEPHONE, LIGHT AND POWER AND ALL WITHHOLDING AND SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES WITHHELD OUT OF WAGES TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT DONALD J. FEIST M.D. BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF SARGENT COUNTY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, SALARY TO BE \$300.00 PER YEAR PLUS MILEAGE AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW. COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER SMITH AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HOFLEN THAT ROBERT A. CASE BE RE-APPOINTED TO THE SARGENT COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD, TERM ENDING 1ST MONDAY IN JANUARY 1968. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO OPEN SEALED PROPOSALS FOR THE DEPOSIT OF PUBLIC FUNDS. PROPOSALS WERE SUBMITTED BY THE SARGENT COUNTY BANK OF FORMAN, THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF MILNOR AND THE BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA, BISMARCK.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT THE SARGENT COUNTY BANK OF FORMAN, THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF MILNOR AND THE BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA OF BISMARCK BE DESIGNATED AS LEGAL DEPOSITORIES OF COUNTY FUNDS FOR THE YEARS 1966 AND 1967.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY MOVED THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER BE GIVEN AUTHORITY TO DESTROY ALL UNUSED 1964 PERSONAL PROPERTY RECEIPTS.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

AS CUSTODIAN AND THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF MILNOR, NORTH DAKOTA, COVERING U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1974 - 4 1/8 % DUE 2/15/74 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 AND U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1980 - 4 % DUE 2/15/80 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 AND U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1974 - 4 1/4 % DUE 5/15/74 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,000.00 WITH THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. AS CUSTODIAN, BE APPROVED AS TO SUFFICIENCY ACCORDING TO LAW.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION TO SELL HARD LIQUOR "ON & OFF SALE" AND TO SELL BEER "ON & OFF SALE" BE APPROVED AND LICENSE ISSUED TO SAME.

RUSSELL GREENLEY, ON LOT 2, BLOCK 2, RANDALL'S ADDITION, VILLAGE OF STIRUM FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JAN. 1ST, 1966 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31ST, 1966.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT IN ORDER TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A SATISFACTORY RAILROAD CROSSING FIVE MILES SOUTH OF COGSWELL, IT IS NECESSARY TO REMOVE SOME OF THE TREES. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT A RIGHT TRIANGLE BE ESTABLISHED WITH ONE LEG 325 FT. IN LENGTH ALONG THE RAILROAD TRACK AND THE OTHER 350 FT. ALONG THE HIGHWAY, WHICH WILL PERMIT A 50 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT AT SAID CROSSING.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE SHERIFF, TO EXAMINE THE DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RECORD AND TO CANCEL THOSE TAXES WHICH IN THE OPINION OF THE BOARD WERE FOUND TO BE UNCOLLECTABLE THROUGH DEATH OF THE OWNER, REMOVAL FROM THE COUNTY OR OTHER VALID REASONS, SAID CANCELLATIONS BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 57-22-11 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES, SAME HAVING BEEN FOUND UNCOLLECTABLE, BE CANCELLED IN THE VARIOUS TAXING DISTRICTS IN THE COUNTY.
