The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.



Commissioner Lee seconded the motion and same carried.




The Board met for the purpose of filling the vacancy of the County Extension Agent office due to the resignation of Fredric Hauser.

Commissioner Lee seconded the motion and same carried.





The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with Commissioners Chesley, Bruns, Johnson and Orth present. Commissioner Lee being absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion approved as read.

Byron Manchett from Miller-Meteor Sales of Minneapolis, Inc. and Roger Dahlstrom from Milnor, North Dakota met with the Commissioners for the purpose of writing up the order for two new ambulances according to the bid of Miller-Meteor Sales of Minneapolis, Inc. and Nelson Implement & Chev. Co., said bid being accepted by the Board on March 7th, 1972.

At the hour of two o'clock P.M. the Board proceeded to hold a public hearing in regards to the expansion of the Sargent County Water Management District to include the drainage districts in Sargent County as advertised in the Official Newspaper on February 23rd and March 1st, 1972.

The County Auditor reported to the Board that he had received no objections from benefited landowners in writing opposing the expansion of the Water Management District to include the drainage districts. The following persons were present for said hearing.

William Bosse, Milton Bergsjoe and Ole Breum representing the Water Management District. Everett Stevens and Milton Bergsjoe representing the Sargent County Drainage Districts. Olaf Olson being absent. Archie and Mike Paczkowski and Harry Kiefer from Marboe Township and Harris Anderson from Weber Township.

After considerable discussion Commissioner Bruns introduced the Following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, it appears that no benefited landowners have filed objections to the expansion of the Water Management District to include the Sargent County Drainage Districts, and

WHEREAS, it appears that no verbal objections were expressed at the public hearing, and

WHEREAS, it appears that during the discussions held at the public hearing the expansion of the Water Management Districts would be of mutual benefit to all property owners concerned and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County, North Dakota that the Sargent County Water Management District be expanded to include the Sargent County Drainage Districts as follows: Tri-County Drain No. 1; Hall-Herman Drain No. 2; Bi-County Drain No. 3; City of Forman Drain No. 4; Dunbar Drain No. 5; Sargent County - Denver-Marlem-Sargent Drain No. 6; Milnor City Drain No. 7; Rutland Village (NOW CITY) Drain No. 8; Taylor-Brampton Drain No. 9; Crete-Cogswell Drain No. 11; Marboe Drain No. 12; Ransom Drain No. 13; Old Havana Tile Drain No. 14; Bowen-Dunbar Drain No. 15; Cogswell Drain No. 16; Dunbar-Shuman Drain No. 17; Forman-Bowen-Dunbar Drain No. 18; Havana Tile Drain No. 19. Said expansion to become effective March 30th, 1972, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all the above ^{named} Drainage Districts be dissolved and the properties of the above named districts be transferred to the Sargent County Water Management District, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Auditor and the County Treasurer be hereby authorized and directed to transfer all funds in the various Drainage Districts to the Sargent County Water Management District effective March 30th, 1972.

Commissioner Orth seconded the adoption of the above resolution.


