

FORMAN, NORTH DAKOTA, JAN. 5TH, 1965

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY RALPH SEAVERY, COUNTY AUDITOR, AND THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE WAS ADMINISTERED TO THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS WHO WERE ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 3RD, 1964, FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS. MELVIN SMITH, 4TH DISTRICT AND GEORGE R. BRUNS, 5TH DISTRICT.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT COMMISSIONER ENGE BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED AS READ.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-11-36 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE BE ADOPTED AND THAT COMMISSIONER DEWEY BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS COURTHOUSE

COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AND THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED TO SERVE AS ROAD & BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE COMMISSIONERS FROM OTHER DISTRICTS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY, AND THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITOR'S WARRANTS THE FOLLOWING: ALL SALARIES, INCLUDING JANITORS, CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR AND CLERK HIRE AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT, ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALL BILLS FOR TELEPHONE, LIGHT AND POWER AND ALL WITHHOLDING AND SOCIAL SECURITY TAXES WITHHELD OUT OF WAGES TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY MOVED THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER BE GIVEN AUTHORITY TO DESTROY ALL UNUSED 1963 TAX RECEIPTS. COMMISSIONER BRUNS SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT DONALD J. FEIST M.D. BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF SARGENT COUNTY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, SALARY TO BE \$300.00 PER YEAR PLUS MILEAGE AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW. COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER SMITH AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER DEWEY THAT DONALD J. FEIST M.D. BE RE-APPOINTED TO THE SARGENT COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD, TERM ENDING 1ST MONDAY IN JANUARY 1967. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER DEWEY AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BRUNS THAT WM. BOSSE OF COGSWELL, NORTH DAKOTA BE RE-APPOINTED DISTRICT COMMISSIONER OF THE SARGENT COUNTY WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT, TERM ENDING FEBRUARY 6TH, 1970. MOTION CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT THE PUBLIC DEPOSITORY AGREEMENT, FOR PLEDGE OF ASSETS AS SECURITY FOR COUNTY FUNDS IN THE SARGENT COUNTY BANK OF FORMAN, NORTH DAKOTA, COVERING \$50,000.00 U.S. TREASURY NOTES SERIES B-1966 - 3 5/8 % # 19295/99 @ 10 M EACH DUE 2/15/66 AND \$50,000.00 THE CHASE NATIONAL BANK, N.Y. RECEIPT FOR TWELVE FEDERAL LAND BANKS - 4 1/4 % CONS. FEDERAL FARM LOAN BONDS, # 2215/9 @ 10 M EACH DUE 7/20/66 WITH THE NORTHWESTERN BANK OF MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. AS CUSTODIAN AND THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF MILNOR, NORTH DAKOTA, COVERING U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1967 - 3 5/8 % DUE 11/15/67 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 AND U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1980 - 4 % DUE 2/15/80 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 AND U.S. TREASURY BONDS OF 1974 - 4 1/4 % DUE 5/15/74 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,000.00 WITH THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT THE SURETY BOND OF THE SARGENT COUNTY TELLER, AS OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF SARGENT COUNTY IN THE SUM OF \$1000.00, WITH WESTERN SURETY CO. AS SURETY AND HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE STATE'S ATTORNEY AS TO FORM, BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS TO SUFFICIENCY.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER SMITH AND SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HOFLEN THAT THE FOLLOWING SALE OF COUNTY TAX DEED PROPERTY BE APPROVED AND DEED ISSUED TO PURCHASER:

ON MOTION THE BOARD APPROVED PAYMENTS MADE BY THE SARGENT COUNTY WELFARE BOARD IN THE SUM OF \$2,267.20 FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER AND FOR WHICH WARRANT NOS. 9818 TO 9831 AND 9896 TO 9903 INCLUSIVE HAD BEEN ISSUED.

A DELEGATION CONSISTING OF THE FOLLOWING PERSONS, HANS KLEINGARN, GEORGE KRIZ, RUSSELL KLEINGARN, PETER J. BANISH, EVAN KLEINGARN, ROMAN PIETERICK, THOMAS A. BANISH, LEONARD KRATCHA, JAY HARING JR. AND LOWELL KRIZ MET WITH THE COMMISSIONERS IN REGARDS TO THE POSSIBILITY OF SECURING A BRIDGE ON THE WILDRICE RIVER LOCATED BETWEEN SECTION 36, TWP. 131, RGE 54 IN SHUMAN TOWNSHIP AND SECTION 1, TWP. 130, RGE 54 IN RANSOM TOWNSHIP.

THE GROUP WERE ADVISED TO MEET WITH THE TOWNSHIP BOARDS OF RANSOM AND SHUMAN TOWNSHIPS AND SECURE A COMMITMENT THAT ONE MILE GOOD ROAD WOULD BE BUILT EAST AND WEST OF THE WILDRICE RIVER BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WOULD GIVE ANY CONSIDERATION TO BUILDING A BRIDGE.

BUB MURPHY, DISTRICT CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR AND HARLAN KLEFSTAD, COUNTY CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR MET WITH THE BOARD IN REGARDS TO INSTALLING A SHORT WAVE RADIO COMMUNICATION SYSTEM IN SARGENT COUNTY AND PARTICIPATING WITH RANSOM COUNTY IN SETTING UP ONE BASE STATION TO SERVE BOTH COUNTIES.

IT WAS DECIDED TO CONTACT THE VARIOUS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS AND FIND OUT IF THEY WOULD USE THIS SERVICE IF IT WAS AVAILABLE, AND THAT THE BOARD WOULD MEET ON JANUARY 18TH, 1965 TO MAKE THEIR DECISION.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE SHERIFF, TO EXAMINE THE DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RECORD AND TO CANCEL THOSE TAXES WHICH IN THE OPINION OF THE BOARD WERE FOUND TO BE UNCOLLECTABLE THROUGH DEATH OF THE OWNER, REMOVAL FROM THE COUNTY, OR OTHER VALID REASONS, SAID CANCELLATIONS BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 57-22-11 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS, CHAPTER 57-22-21 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE PROVIDES THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL AT ITS JANUARY MEETING, DECLARE BY RESOLUTION THAT ALL UNPAID AND UNCANCELLED PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES SHALL CONSTITUTE A LIEN ON ANY REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE TAX DEBTOR, FROM AND AFTER THE DATE OF EXTENSION AND ENTRY THEREOF BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR UPON THE TAX LIST OF THE NEXT PROCEEDING YEAR, OPPOSITE THE DESCRIPTIONS OF REAL ESTATE DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BELONGING TO ANY PERSON, COMPANY OR CORPORATION OWING SUCH UNCOLLECTED PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES, THE YEAR OR YEARS FOR WHICH THE TAX REMAINS DUE AND THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF SUCH TAX AND THAT SUCH ENTRY SHALL BE MADE WITHOUT REGARDS TO ANY PRIOR PAYMENT OF REAL ESTATE TAXES ON SAID DESCRIPTIONS FOR THE PROCEEDING YEAR, AND THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL BE WITHOUT AUTHORITY THEREAFTER TO ISSUE ANY RECEIPT IN FULL FOR SAID REAL ESTATE TAXES WITHOUT MAKING COLLECTION AT THE SAME TIME, THE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES SO EXTENDED; A TAXPAYER HOLDING A SPECIFIC LIEN ON SAID DESCRIPTIONS AHEAD OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES CHARGED THEREON SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A TAX RECEIPT WITHOUT REGARDS TO NON-PAYMENT OF SUCH INFERIOR PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES, AND

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT ALL UNPAID AND UNCOLLECTED DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES FROM AND AFTER THE DATE OF EXTENSION AND ENTRY THEREOF AS PROVIDED IN THE FOREGOING MINUTES, SHALL CONSTITUTE A LIEN ON ANY REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE TAX DELINQUENT, OR WHICH MAY THERE AFTER BE ACQUIRED BY THE TAX DELINQUENT, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE FOLLOWING PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES OWED SHALL BE A SPECIFIC LIEN UPON THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

AND WHEREAS, THE PRESENT STATE POLICE RADIO NETWORK IS INADEQUATE TO SERVICE THESE NEEDS AND DOES NOT ADAPT ITSELF TO THE ADDITION OF THE FURTHER UNITS NEEDED;

AND WHEREAS, IT IS DETERMINED FEASEABLE TO ESTABLISH A NETWORK OF RADIO SERVICE THAT WOULD PROVIDE ONE MAIN STATION FOR THE COUNTIES OF RANSOM AND SARGENT;

AND WHEREAS, THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SUCH A RADIO NETWORK WOULD BE A FURTHERANCE OF THE CIVIL DEFENSE PROGRAM AND SAID PROGRAM WOULD SHARE THE COST THEROF IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-HALF OF THE COST THEREOF;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE COUNTY OF RANSOM AND THE COUNTY OF SARGENT IN THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, ESTABLISH JOINTLY A LOCAL RADIO NETWORK, THE COST OF THE MAIN STATION OF WHICH SHALL BE SHARED EQUALLY BY THE TWO COUNTIES, LESS ALL COSTS THEROF SHARED TO THE STATE CIVIL DEFENSE PROGRAM;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE COST OF ALL MOBIL UNITS USED OR NEEDED WILL BE THE COST AND EXPENSE OF EACH OF THE VARIOUS COUNTIES, DEPARTMENTS AND UNITS SERVED UNDER THE NETWORK;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT RANSOM COUNTY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PERIODIC CHECKING OF THE MAIN STATION EQUIPMENT, BUT THAT THE COST OF ALL UPKEEP AND MAINTENANCE ON THE MAIN STATION SHALL BE SHARED EQUALLY BETWEEN RANSOM AND SARGENT COUNTIES.

COMMISSIONER DICK SECONDED THE RESOLUTION.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS VOTED "AYE", HOFLEN, ENGE, DEWEY, SMITH, BRUNS, ULMER, DICK AND TOYNE, AND THE FOLLOWING VOTED "NAY", NONE.


