THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO LAW, AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COUNTY AUDITOR, R. W. SAFSTROM.

THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE WAS ADMINISTERED TO THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS WHO WERE ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOV. 5TH, 1940: GEO. C. DAWSON, 4TH DISTRICT; A. F. SAEWERT, 5TH DISTRICT.

MR. LOUDEN MOVED THAT MR. GEO. C. DAWSON BE ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. MR. SAEWERT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

MR. SAEWERT MOVED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER OF BUSINESS BE ADOPTED FOR THE ENSUING YEAR: FIRST, ROLL CALL; SECOND, READING OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING; THIRD, UNFINISHED BUSINESS; FOURTH, APPLICATIONS AND PETITIONS; FIFTH, BILLS; SIXTH, MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS; SEVENTH, ADJOURNMENT.

MR. ANDERSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY MR. LOUDEN AND SECONDED BY MR. SAEWERT THAT MR. OBED A. WYUM BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. MOTION CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE OTHER COMMISSIONERS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY.

MOVED BY MR. ANDERSON AND SECONDED BY MR. LOUDEN THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITORS WARRANTS ALL SALARIES AND CLERK HIRE AND JANITORS SALARIES FOR THE ENSUING YEAR 1941, AS FIXED BY THE BOARD OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT, ALSO ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE COUNTY PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND ALSO ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE STATE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE RURAL REHABILITATION CORPORATION OR ITS SUCCESSORS AND SARGENT COUNTY OF COLLECTIONS MADE FOR LIVESTOCK FEED ASSISTANCE LOANS. MOTION CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

MR. SAEWERT MOVED THAT F. G. HUBBARD, M. D., BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

MR. ANDERSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. SAEWERT THAT THE SALARY OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR BE FIXED AT \$300.00, SAME BEING THE MINIMUM AMOUNT THAT THE LAW ALLOWS, AND THAT THE MILEAGE BE FIXED AT 5 CENTS PER MILE NECESSARILY TRAVELED.

MR. ANDERSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF INSANITY COMMISSIONER.

MR. ANDERSON MOVED THAT A. LESLIE BE APPOINTED INSANITY COMMISSIONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS. MR. SAEWERT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE AUDITOR REPORTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN FILED IN HIS OFFICE THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION NOV. 5TH, 1940, AND THAT HE HAD ON FILE CERTIFICATION FROM THE STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT SHOWING THAT SAID OFFICERS HAD BEEN DULY BONDED BY THE SAID STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW:
