Doug Bartels, GIS Coordinator, Richland County, reported on funding available for GIS software and automated flood warning system. Richland County filed an application on behalf of this area and they were informed that no funds are available at this time but they would like to see if any interest is evident for local support for re-application of grant funds. There are three locations on the Wild Rice River that would impact Sargent County and other Water Resource Boards. The gauges that would be placed would be covered by the grant as well as a software package. They would be equipped with several features that are powered by solar energy. If a situation occurs, these gauges will go through a call list and contact individuals that would be involved in an emergency situation. Board members discussed specific locations, cost of the project and recommended that Mr. Bartels visit with the Sargent County Water Board for additional input and support.

Irv Rustad, Lake Agassiz Regional Council met with the Board to explain the various programs that are active with LARC for small business loans. They include Micro Loans (ML), Intermediate Relending Program (IRP) and Community Development Financial Institution Fund (CDFI). Mr. Rustad informed the Board the monies in the CDFI fund might be returned to the county upon a written request. Request the portion of CDFI funds available to Sargent County be returned effective immediately and on an annual basis until repaid. These funds shall be deposited in the Capital Improvement Fund. (Wyum/Orn) Roll call: Aye: Walstead, Orn, Wyum, Anderson and Waswick. Nay: none. Motion carried.

The Board recessed at 12:00 noon for lunch.

The Board reconvened at 1:20 p.m.

The Board received copies of the county audit for the year ended December 31, 2005 from the Office of the ND State Auditor.

A credit card policy was prepared as per a recommendation in the state audit for the Sheriff's Dept. After review of the policy by Board members and Travis Paeper, Sheriff, motion to approve and implement the policy effective November 1, 2006. (Walstead/Orn, unanimous)

John Waller, Administrator, Region V Child Support Unit and Wendy Jacobson, Sargent/Ransom County Social Service Director met with the Board. Mr. Waller explained the importance of the child support unit and procedures that are followed to provide the best assistance for this region.

Sparky Engquist, Road Supt. and Mark Breker, Chairman, Water Board met with the Board to discuss the County No. 14 road and Drain No. 3 project. There has been no response from FEMA on an improved project request that was filed in September. There is concern on safety of this roadway and the need to get this work completed before winter. The Board suggests that the Water Board proceed with the project and the road department will do the work. Sparky discussed load restrictions that were discussed at the SE County Commission meeting held on October 6th. There is some problem with uniformity in Sargent County and other area counties and a problem with signing. He will coordinate with other road supervisors in determining the number of signs to order. Sparky asked permission to transfer the computer from the commission room to the highway department for use in inventory of signs, bridges, culverts and GIS. Approved.

Norm Preble, Tax Director was called in the meeting to discuss the appraisal on the Five Star Dairy located in Hall Township. He indicated the ND State Tax Dept. has some concerns with the conditional permit. A phone call was placed to the tax department and Board members asked questions about a payment in lieu of taxes. It was the Board's consensus that Norm Preble, Tax

Director, Hall Township Board of Supervisors and Lyle Bopp, States Attorney should place a call to the state tax department to discuss the appraisal of the dairy operation.

Election worker per diem was reviewed for the upcoming General Election. Approve reimbursement for election workers at \$150 per day if worker attends the training session and \$100 if they do not for the 2006 General Election and future elections unless revised by the commission. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous) Mileage will be paid for officials that return the ballots to the courthouse on election night.

The City of Milnor Mayor and City Council sent a letter to the commissioners and sheriff regarding better communication between the public and law enforcement. Police Commissioner Jerry Waswick will visit with Sheriff Paeper about the letter.

Approve appointment of Kristine Askerooth as a North Dakota State Fair delegate representing Sargent County. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)

Approve removal of item #1487 (fax machine) from the county inventory. (Anderson/Orn, unanimous)

Verification of pledge of assets for 2006 was received from the county treasurer. Sargent County Bank, Forman has \$4,655,000 in pledges and First National Bank, Milnor \$2,325,000 in pledges. According to the treasurer, both are adequate according to law. Accept. (Wyum/Walstead, unanimous)
