The Board of County Commissioners of Sargent met at the office of the County Auditor in regular session, pursuant to law.

Present Messrs Straub Marcellus, Peterson and Dietzler, Mr. Motion Mr. Marcellus was elected Chairman Pro Tem.

Cancellation of 1887 tax against N.W. 1/4 Sec 8, 130-57

Mr. Peterson moved that the 1887 tax against the N.W. 1/4 Sec 8 Twp. 130 Rng. 57 be cancelled for the reason that said property was Government Land till 1898, which motion prevailed. all voting yes.

Mr. Straub moved that the 1904 School-poll against Michael Doyle in Village of Havana be cancelled, he having paid a school-poll for the same year in Nebraska Township. which motion prevailed.

Cancellation of 1902 tax on lot 8, Block 32, Milner

Mr. Dietzler moved that the 1902 tax on lot 8 in block 32 Town of Milner be cancelled for the reason that the same is Church property and not subject to taxation. which motion prevailed.

Mr. Straub moved that the valuation for the years 1904 and 1905 on lots 9 & 10 Sec 31-130-54 be reduced to \$60. said tract having only 20 acres and having been assessed for 80 acres. which motion prevailed.
