The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. with the following present: W.E. Smith, Don Wehlander, Lysle Coleman, Ray Brockman and Steve Wyum. Absent none.

Approve October 8 and 21, 1999 minutes. (Wyum/Wehlander, unanimous)

Approve Games of Chance No. 99-06 to DeLamere Hall Association for bingo on 11-13-99, 1-22-00 and 4-8-00. (Wyum/Coleman, unanimous)

The Board proceeded to conduct a hearing on minimum sales price for land forfeited to the county for non-payment of taxes. No one was present. The sales prices and the properties for sale shall be published under NOTICE OF SALE OF REAL ESTATE FORFEITED TO THE COUNTY FOR DELINQUENT TAXES.

Sparky Engquist reported that Marshall Johnson resigned his position with the Road Department effective November 4, 1999. The Board instructed him to review applications on file and contact to see if interested in the job. If no one is available, he should place an advertisement in the paper.

Approve extension of summer hours for road department at Supervisor discretion through 1999. (Wyum/Coleman, unanimous)

Sandy Hanson, DES, reported a problem with mold on the walls in the Health District Office. She has contacted FEMA and there would be 95%/5% match for repairs to correct this problem. The Board encouraged her to pursue funding.

Approve non-employee compensation for extra work performed from FEMA Disaster Assistance Administration Fee funds (1099 to be issued) to Sandra Hanson for \$3,500. (Coleman/Brockman, unanimous)

Jerry Nankivel, Parole and Probation Officer provided the Board with information on that program. Sargent County collected \$4,320 and 2,481 hours of community service. A secretary has been hired and will be reclassified next year and assigned some of the workload. Approve continuation of the Parole and Probation Program in Sargent County. (Wyum/Wehlander, unanimous)

Joan Lee asked about purchasing a computer that is no longer used in the Register of Deeds Office. Government property must be bid. Authorize notice to receive sealed bids for the computer, 2 printers and a switch box. Bids will be opened November 16, 1999.
