COMMISSIONER SAEWERT INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS, DUE TO THE RECENT FLOOD WATERS A NUMBER OF BRIDGES IN SARGENT COUNTY WERE DAMAGED TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE UNSAFE AND UNFIT FOR TRAFFIC PURPOSES WITH NO POSSIBLE DETOURS, GREAT HARDSHIPS ARE BEING WORKED ON THE TRAVELING PUBLIC AND THE PEOPLE RESIDING IN THE AREAS ADJACENT TO SAID BRIDGES, AND ESPECIALLY ON FARMERS WHO HAVE TO CROSS THESE BRIDGES IN ORDER TO MOVE FROM ONE FIELD TO ANOTHER, CREATING A SERIOUS SITUATION WHICH SHOULD BE CORRECTED WITHOUT ANY DELAY,

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT AN EMERGENCY BE HEREBY DECLARED TO EXIST AND THAT THE GLASSER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY BE ENGAGED TO PROCEED TO REPAIR THE BRIDGES LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

BETWEEN SECTIONS 26 AND 14 AND 2 AND 11, 132-58, DENVER TOWNSHIP
BETWEEN SECTIONS 29 AND 30 AND 26 AND 25, 132-53, HALL TOWNSHIP
BETWEEN SECTIONS 5 AND 8, 131-53, HERMAN TOWNSHIP
BETWEEN SECTIONS 31 AND 32, 130-53, KINGSTON TOWNSHIP
IN CENTER OF SECTION 23-131-53, HERMAN TOWNSHIP ON HIGHWAY L.

COMMISSIONER LOUDEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

ON MOTION THE BOARD APPROVED THE SURETY BOND OF GLOBE-GAZETTE PRINTING COMPANY, FURNISHED IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR CONTRACT FOR SUPPLYING RECORDS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE COUNTY, WITH NATIONAL SURETY CORPORATION AS SURETY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00, AS TO SUFFICIENCY, SAME HAVING BEEN APPROVED AS TO FORM BY THE STATE'S ATTORNEY.

ON MOTION THE BOARD ALLOWED, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE STATE TAX COMMISSIONER, THE APPLICATION OF HULDA JOHNSTON FOR A REFUND OF 1941 TAXES ON LOT 16, BLOCK 5, VILLAGE OF GWINNER, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8.37, FOR THE REASON THAT STRUCTURES HAD ERRONEOUSLY BEEN ASSESSED ON THE LOT, THE VALUATION FOR 1942 TO BE REDUCED TO \$75.00 (100%).
