THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE BOARD ADJOURN AS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND PROCEED TO ORGANIZE AS BOARD OF REVIEW AND EQUALIZATION.
COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE NEXT PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE AS BOARD OF REVIEW AND EQUALIZATION, WITH COMMISSIONER SMITH ACTING AS CHAIRMAN ACCORDING TO CHAPTER 57-12-01 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE.

ON MOTION THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO REVIEW THE ASSESSMENT OF FARM LANDS, VILLAGE AND CITY LOTS, INCLUDING STRUCTURES ON VILLAGE AND CITY LOTS AND FOUND THAT THE ASSESSORS HAD COMPLIED WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 57-02-11 OF THE NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE, WHICH PROVIDES THAT REAL ESTATE, INCLUDING STRUCTURES BE ASSESSED FOR THE EVEN NUMBERED YEARS AT THE SAME VALUE AS LEFT BY THE STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR.
