THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH COMMISSIONERS ENGE, DEWEY, SMITH AND HOFLEN PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED AS READ.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS INTRODUCED AND PASSED:

IN MEMORY OF COMMISSIONER GLENN B. COLEMAN WHO DIED JUNE 21ST, 1964.

WHEREAS, THE SUPREME RULER OF THE UNIVERSE HAS, IN HIS INFINITE WISDOM THOUGHT BEST TO SUMMON FROM THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND FROM THIS LIFE, COMMISSIONER GLENN B. COLEMAN TO HIS ETERNAL HOME, AND

WHEREAS, COMMISSIONER COLEMAN WAS A TRUE AND FAITHFUL PUBLIC SERVANT, PUBLIC SPIRITED, AND HAVING THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COMMUNITY, STATE AND NATION ALWAYS AT HEART,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT, NORTH DAKOTA, THAT IN THE DEATH OF COMMISSIONER COLEMAN, THE COUNTY OF SARGENT HAS LOST A VALUABLE PUBLIC OFFICIAL, AND THIS COMMUNITY HAS LOST A GOOD CITIZEN, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE SYMPATHY OF THIS COMMISSION BE AND IS HEREBY EXTENDED TO HIS BEREAVED FAMILY IN THEIR DEEP SORROW AND GREAT LOSS, AND COMMEND THEM TO THE CARE AND PROTECTION AND CONSOLATION OF HIM "WHO DOES ALL THINGS WELL".

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION. ON ROLL CALL VOTE COMMISSIONERS DEWEY, SMITH, HOFLEN, ENGE, COUNTY AUDITOR RALPH SEAVERT AND COUNTY JUDGE CASPER SMEDSRUD VOTED "AYE". NO ONE VOTED "NAY" AND LYSLE COLEMAN WAS DULY DECLARED APPOINTED COUNTY COMMISSIONER FOR THE 5TH COMMISSIONER DISTRICT.
