COMMISSIONER SAEWERT MOVED THAT THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE CONTRACT FOR DEED COVERING OUTLOT P, VILLAGE OF HAVANA, AUDITORS PLAT, MADE BY ROSA RICHARDSON IN FAVOR OF EDWARD ELLINGSON BE APPROVED. COMMISSIONER RONNING SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER SAEWERT MOVED THAT THE COUNTY AGREE TO FURNISH THE SUM OF \$200.00 OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN MACHINE HIRE THROUGH THE USE OF COUNTY EQUIPMENT, PROVIDED THAT THE STATE GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT MATCH THIS SUM AND FURNISH ANY ADDITIONAL MONEY THAT MIGHT BE REQUIRED.

COMMISSIONER RONNING SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED AND THE STATE GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT WAS REQUESTED TO TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION TO REPAIR DAMAGE TO IMPROVEMENTS AT SILVER LAKE AND LAKE TEWAUKON CAUSED BY LAST SPRINGS FLOOD WATERS, IN COOPERATION WITH THE SARGENT COUNTY WILD LIFE ASSOCIATION.

COMMISSIONER LOUDEN INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

"WHEREAS BUDGETARY STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE CASES HAVE BEEN INCREASED FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR TO MEET THE INCREASED COST OF LIVING, WHICH IN SOME CASES WILL AMOUNT TO BETWEEN \$20.00 AND \$30.00 OVER AND ABOVE THE AMOUNTS FURNISHED THROUGH PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FUNDS, AND

WHEREAS THE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF SARGENT COUNTY HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO MEET THIS INCREASE, AND

WHEREAS SARGENT COUNTY HAS LEVIED THE MAXIMUM LIMIT OF TAXES ALLOWED BY LAW AND DUE TO THE LOW VALUATION OF THE COUNTY SUCH TAXES ARE INSUFFICIENT TO MEET ORDINARY EXPENDITURES AND THE COUNTY IS WITHOUT FUNDS TO REPAIR DAMAGES TO BRIDGES AND HIGHWAYS TO THE EXTENT OF \$60,000.00, CAUSED BY LAST SPRINGS FLOOD WATERS, IT IS THE OPINION OF THE BOARD THAT SARGENT COUNTY IS AT THIS TIME UNABLE TO ASSUME THIS ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT STATE AND FEDERAL AUTHORITIES BE REQUESTED TO INCREASE THEIR RESPECTIVE ALLOTMENTS TO THE EXTENT THAT SARGENT COUNTY BE NOT REQUIRED TO PAY MORE THAN ITS PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE INCREASE"

COMMISSIONER SAEWERT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED AND THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED, ALL VOTING AYE.
