

FORMAN, N. DAK. JULY 9, 1946.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD.

ON MOTION THE BOARD GRANTED THE APPLICATION OF ROMAN WALDERA FOR LICENSE TO SELL HARD LIQUOR ON AND OFF LOTS 20, 21, 22, BLOCK 8, VILLAGE OF VEDA FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1946, AND ORDERED LICENSE ISSUED.

MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KINGSTON, MARBOE AND TEWAUKON TOWNSHIPS MET WITH THE BOARD AND CONFERRED IN REGARD TO THE MATTER OF CONSTRUCTING A HIGHWAY ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LAKE TEWAUKON.

COMMISSIONER H. C. LOUDEN INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS KINGSTON, MARBOE AND TEWAUKON TOWNSHIPS HAVE AGREED TO CONSTRUCT AND GRAVEL SURFACE A GOOD ROAD TO BE BUILT FROM THE BRIDGE AT THE WEST INLET TO LAKE TEWAUKON ALONG THE LAKE SHORE AND CONTINUING AROUND THE EAST BAY OF THE LAKE, CONNECTING WITH THE PRESENT GRAVEL ROAD ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SEC. 32-130-53, L. T. L. A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 4 MILES, DETOURING AROUND THE BUILDINGS OWNED BY C. E. MOVIUS TO THE NORTH WHERE A BRIDGE WOULD BE CONSTRUCTED ACROSS THE WILD RICE RIVER, PROVIDED THAT THE COUNTY AGREES TO DEFRAY THE COST OF THE BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION AND ONE-HALF OF THE EXPENSE OF BUILDING AND GRAVEL SURFACING THE ROAD AND TO MAINTAIN THE ROAD AFTER IT IS COMPLETED WITHOUT COST TO THE TOWNSHIPS,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT SARGENT COUNTY AGREES TO PAY THE COST OF BUILDING THE BRIDGE AND ONE-HALF OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION, CULVERTS AND GRAVEL SURFACING OF THE ROAD AND ALSO AGREES TO MAINTAIN THE ROAD WITHOUT COST TO THE TOWNSHIPS, PROVIDED THAT ALL EASEMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROAD BE FURNISHED WITHOUT COST TO THE COUNTY AND THAT CONSTRUCTION BE NOT COMMENCED UNTIL IN THE SPRING OF 1947.

COMMISSIONER GEO. DAWSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.
