

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:
 WHEREAS, THE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,727.90 OF ARCHIE CAMPBELL, INC. RECEIVED IN THE LETTING OF AUGUST 16TH, 1963, FOR PROJECT CS 404(2) WAS THE LOW BID RECEIVED.

WHEREAS, THIS BID IS CONSIDERED REASONABLE AND IS UNDER THE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE.
 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT COUNTY, THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT BE REQUESTED TO AWARD TO THE ARCHIE CAMPBELL, INC. THE CONTRACT FOR PROJECT CS 404(2) AND SECURE FEDERAL CONCURRENCE THEREOF.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD THAT THE COUNTY SHALL REIMBURSE THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR ANY PAYMENTS MADE UNDER THIS CONTRACT, WHICH ARE NOT COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS.
