THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD IN AUGUST WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

ON MOTION THE BOARD APPROVED THE REPORT OF SHERIFF L. R. KERLING, OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED DURING THE MONTH OF AUGUST, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$187.20.

A. W. LARSE MET WITH THE BOARD IN REGARD TO HIGHWAY MATTERS.

LOGAN DUWALL APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD IN REGARD TO SETTLEMENT OF SEED LOAN.

COMMISSIONER KIEFER MOVED THAT THE SUM OF \$105.00 BE ACCEPTED AS SETTLEMENT IN FULL OF SEED LOAN NOTE GIVEN BY LOGAN DUWALL.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.
