THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT DEEDS BE ISSUED TO THE FOLLOWING PERSONS WHO HAD REDEEMED THEIR LAND FROM TAX DEED PROCEEDINGS BY PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING TAXES:

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE COMPLETION OF FAS PROJECT 8838(1), (HIGHWAY H IN DUNBAR AND SHUMAN TOWNSHIPS) TO ACQUIRE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY THROUGH CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 24-0510 OF THE NO. DAK. REVISED CODE OF 1943, AND

WHEREAS, THE SEVERAL DESCRIPTIONS OF PROPERTY NECESSARY TO BE TAKEN TOGETHER WITH THE RECORD OWNERS THEREOF ARE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS THE ABOVE MENTIONED OWNERS OF SAID DESCRIBED PARCELS OF LAND HAVE REFUSED TO GIVE EASEMENTS AND THAT FOR THAT REASON IT IS NECESSARY TO ACQUIRE SAID PROPERTY BY CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT A SPECIAL BOARD CONSISTING OF THE COUNTY AUDITOR, COUNTY TREASURER AND REGISTER OF DEEDS OF SARGENT COUNTY, BE AND ARE HEREBY APPOINTED TO ASCERTAIN THE AMOUNT OF DAMAGES TO BE AWARDED TO THE SAID OWNERS AND THAT SAID SPECIAL BOARD IS HEREBY DIRECTED TO COMPLETE SAID CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FORTHWITH ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAP. 24-0511 OF THE NO. DAK. REVISED CODE OF 1943.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED AND THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITIONS FILED FOR THE ANNEXATION OF SOUTH WEST SCHOOL DISTRICT TO BRAMPTON SCHOOL DISTRICT, AS ADVERTISED, AND HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE NO. DAK. STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC SCHOOL EDUCATION.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT THE PETITION BE ALLOWED, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND THAT SOUTH WEST SCHOOL DISTRICT BE DECLARED TO BE A PART OF BRAMPTON SCHOOL DISTRICT.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITIONS FILED FOR THE ANNEXATION OF NORTHEAST SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 4 TO BRAMPTON SCHOOL DISTRICT AS ADVERTISED, AND SAME HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE NO. DAK. STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION.

COMMISSIONER SMITH MOVED THAT THE PETITION BE ALLOWED, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND THAT NORTHEAST SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 4, BE DECLARED TO BE A PART OF BRAMPTON SCHOOL DISTRICT.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.




COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD IN SEPTEMBER WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE REPORT OF SHERIFF MILTON FAY IN THE SUM OF \$2,295.73 FOR DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER BE APPROVED.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

"BE IT RESOLVED BY A MAJORITY OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT COUNTY THAT AIRCRAFT OPERATORS QUALIFYING UNDER THE REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE GAME AND FISH COMMISSIONER MAY HUNT COYOTE AND FOX WITHIN THE ABOVE MENTIONED COUNTY".

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED, AND THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED.

COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE MOVED THAT QUIT CLAIM DEED BE ISSUED TO ROBERT A. DARLAND, COVERING SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SEC. 31-130-58, IN LIEU OF DEED CLAIMED TO BE LOST.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD MET WITH THE BOARD AND DISCUSSED THE MATTER OF REPAIRING SEVERAL BRIDGES ACROSS DRAIN NO. 11. IT WAS AGREED THAT IT WOULD BE NECESSARY TO MAKE A SPECIAL LEVY ON CRETE-COGSWELL DRAIN NO. 11, IN THE SUM OF \$2,500.00 FOR THE YEAR 1958, TO DEFRAY THE COST OF REPAIRING THE BRIDGES AND OTHER INCIDENTALS.

A PETITION SIGNED BY RESIDENTS AND ELECTORS OF VERNER TOWNSHIP REQUESTING THAT THE VOTING PLACE IN VERNER TOWNSHIP BE CHANGED FROM THE SCHOOL HOUSE LOCATED ON THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SEC. 30 TO THE SCHOOL HOUSE LOCATED ON SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SEC. 11, ALL IN TWP. 131, RG. 58.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE ABOVE PETITION BE ALLOWED.
COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE REPORT OF THE EXAMINATION OF THE SARGENT COUNTY OFFICES, COVERING THE PERIOD FROM OCT. 1, 1957 TO SEPT. 9, 1958, AS MADE BY DEPUTY EXAMINERS R. A. LOWE AND R. A. HOEL, WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD AND READ.

A LETTER FROM MR. G. H. RUSS JR., STATE EXAMINER, IN REGARD TO SAID REPORT WAS ALSO READ BY THE BOARD AND CONTENTS NOTED. THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO TAKE IMMEDIATE STEPS TO COMPLY WITH THE SUGGESTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS CONTAINED IN THE LETTER.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO OPEN AND CONSIDER BIDS FOR THE FURNISHING OF LIGNITE COAL FOR SARGENT COUNTY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, AS ADVERTISED.

A BID HAD BEEN FILED BY THE FARMERS CO-OP. ELEVATOR CO. TO FURNISH 6 INCH. AND LIGNITE STOKER COAL AT A PRICE OF \$7.00 PER TON ON TRACK AT FORMAN.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE BID OF THE FARMERS CO-OP. ELEVATOR CO. BE ACCEPTED.
COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER BIDS FOR THE HAULING OF COAL FOR THE COUNTY.

A BID HAD BEEN FILED BY BILL BUSCHE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1.65 PER TON.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HOWARD ROOFING COMPANY, FERGUS FALLS, MINN., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMPLETELY NEW PITCH AND GRAVEL ROOF OVER THE COURTHOUSE, WORK TO BE STARTED ON OR BEFORE OCT. 20, 1958, AT A PRICE OF \$2,987.00.






