THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN MOVED THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED AS READ.
COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:






THE COMMISSIONERS SPENT THE MAJOR PART OF THE DAY IN COURT.

BIDS FOR HAULING COAL FOR THE COUNTY WAS NEXT CONSIDERED.


