## Forman, North Dakota May 20, 2014

The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 a.m. following the meeting of the Sargent County Park Board. The following members were present: Jerry Waswick, Mike Walstead, Steven Wyum, David L Jacobson and Bill Anderson. Absent: None. Also present was Paige Cary, of the Sargent County Teller.

Commissioner Bill Anderson and Forman Ambulance Squad Board Member James Peterson updated Board members on the meetings of some members of the Emergency Services Committee and the Forman Ambulance Squad Board on Tuesday, May 6, and Monday, May 19, to discuss the impending shortage of Emergency Medical Tech (EMT) trained ambulance volunteers. Several different alternatives are being considered. The full committee will meet on May 28<sup>th</sup> to discuss options and make recommendations.

Travis Paeper, Sheriff, provided information to the Board on values of the 2 vehicles that are being considered for trade-in or transfer to the county fleet. After a lengthy discussion, a motion was made to send the 2007 Silver Durango that is currently in the county fleet to the auction; to place a minimum bid of \$4,000 on it; to apply the proceeds to the purchase of the new vehicle for the Sheriff's Department; and, to pay the difference out of the county vehicle line item. (Walstead/Jacobson, unanimous) The total that will be paid for the 2011 Expedition, which shall be transferred to the county fleet shall not exceed \$10,000.

Motion to approve the revised draft of the minutes of the May 6, 2014, commission meeting and April 2014 financial statement. (Waswick/Jacobson. Motion carried)

Mike Walstead, Road Commissioner, provided information on cost for GPS units in the county road maintainers. No action taken at this time.

Gina Hillestad, Treasure/Recorder/Clerk of Court informed Board members of the resignation of her deputy Christine O'Brien, who is relocating out of this area. Her last day of work is July 31. Gina will start advertising for the position and hope to have someone hired by mid-June.

Several department heads along with representatives from Minn-kota Communications, Wahpeton gathered to receive information on a proposed new phone system for the county courthouse. The system is a SBX IP Phone System with 12 lines and capability for 40 extensions. Minn-kota provided a quote for 30 phones, the phone system, and labor to install, program and training of \$12,358.50. Motion to purchase the new phone system using Capital Improvement funds. (Waswick/Walstead, unanimous)

Sparky Engquist, Road Supt., Damon DeVillers and Jesse Sedler, Interstate Engineering, Inc. met with the Board. Damon and Sparky reviewed the bid tabulation for the gravel projects. Sparky had computed cost estimates for performing the work by purchasing gravel from local suppliers, having local haulers transport gravel to project sites and having the County Road Department lay the gravel, and those figures were compared to the low bid submitted by Wm. D. Scepaniak, Inc. of Holdingford, MN. A lengthy discussion followed on pros and cons of hiring a contractor to do the entire gravel project versus the county road department doing the 2014 graveling projects. Motion to accept the Base Bid from Wm. D. Scepaniak, Inc., Holdingford, MN; for 13 miles of gravel on County #5 from Brampton east to County Road #10 for a total bid of \$287,838.80. (Jacobson/Waswick. Roll call vote. Aye: Jacobson, Waswick, Anderson, Wyum. Nay: Walstead. Motion carried)

Mike Walstead, Road Commissioner, made a motion to stockpile 25,000 tons of ND Class 13 Modified gravel in each of the Marlow, Storhaug and Jorgenson pits for use on other road projects pointing out that the average price per ton would be \$3.60 versus the contractor bid of \$4.83 per ton for a difference of \$1.23/ton and a savings of \$92,250. Further that the county will keep a 5% retainage fee on each stockpile pit until all the gravel has been removed from such stockpile and the hauling tickets will determine the amount of gravel from each pit. The States Attorney shall draw up a Memorandum of Sale with each contractor. (Walstead/Anderson. Roll call vote: Aye: Anderson, Walstead, Wyum. Nay: Jacobson and Waswick. Motion carried)

Damon DeVillers presented four copies of the Construction Agreement in the amount of \$2,477,196.55 with regard to the Sargent County # 14 road project including the Notice of Award to Central Specialties, Inc., Alexandria MN. Mr. DeVillers reported that the contractor is planning to begin work on the project in mid-July. Motion to authorize the Chairman and County Auditor to sign and execute each document pending examination and approval by the States Attorney. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous)

Motion to authorize the Chairman and County Auditor to sign and execute the Notice of Award to Wm. D. Scepaniak, Inc. for the gravel project. (Jacobson/Anderson, unanimous)

Damon DeVillers also informed the Board that four of the ER grade raise projects sustained damage to the slopes this Spring from high wind and wave action, and, according to NDDOT, the projects are still open and eligible for additional work. The contractor, Riley Bros., will place riprap on these sites as soon as possible. Damon also reported that the Cayuga project is about 5-6 weeks away from the project start date due to the late Spring and the fact that the aggregate for producing the hot mix paving material is not yet available from the contractor's local supplier.

Motion to approve an Application for ditch cleaning Work within County Road Right-of-Way to C & H Farm, Brampton Farm Service 200 Main, Brampton, ND for ditch cleaning and driveway installation between Section 11 and 12 of Brampton Township on County # 4 road. (Walstead/Waswick, unanimous)

Steve Wyum, Chairman left the meeting at this time. Vice Chairman Mike Walstead presided over the remainder of the meeting.

Jerry Waswick agreed to represent the county commission on the June 16 Primary Election County Canvass Board.

Motion to approve an Application for a permit to conduct public dances for a period of 12 months at the Geneseo Hall. (Anderson/Jacobson, unanimous)

Jerry Waswick requested that the County Auditor contact Marsha Mathias, Vivian Township Clerk regarding a new accounting system for townships and suggest that she contact the accounting company to come to the Sargent County Township Officers meeting for a demonstration of this program to all the townships and that any cost incurred would be the responsibility of the individual township or the township association.

Meeting adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
