The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 10:15 a.m., following the meeting of the Sargent County Park Board, with the following members present: Mike Walstead, David L Jacobson, Jerry Waswick and Steven Wyum. Absent: Bill Anderson. Also present was Paige Cary, the Sargent County Teller.

Bids were opened for surplus property owned by Sargent County. Motion to accept all high bids on all items and all items without a bid be offered for \$1.00 and authorize the County Auditor to dispose of remaining items as she deems appropriate. (Waswick/Wyum, unanimous)

Sandy Hanson, Tax Director arrived at the meeting with two Applications for Abatement and Settlement of 2012 Taxes that were returned from Milnor City and Denver Township for the following properties: Lot 4, Block 2, Park Lane Addition, Milnor City – Scott and Leslie Strouse and Lot 1 & 2, Block 5, Auditor's Plat, Village of Crete, Denver Township – David R Jenson. The two properties had mobile home values computed on their taxable valuation. Mobile home valuations may be handled differently then the valuation of structures attached to real estate and the valuations had been computed twice. The abatement will refund the duplicate tax paid for the mobile home. Milnor City approved the Strouse abatement and Denver Township approved the Jenson abatement. Motion to concur with Milnor City and Denver Township (Walstead/Waswick, unanimous)

Sandy Hanson notified the Board that the Sargent County Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Sub-Agreement has been approved for a total of \$49,200 of which \$36,900 is Federal funds, \$4,920 of State Funds and \$7,380 in Local funds. The local funds can be in-kind contributions from local communities, local responders and fire departments. Sandy requested that Lyle Bopp, States Attorney review the agreement prior to execution. Authorize the Chairman to sign the agreement subject to review by the States Attorney. (Wyum/Walstead, unanimous) The completion date for the program is March, 2016. Chairman Jacobson appointed Bill Anderson, Commissioner to serve on this Board.

Damon DeVillers, Interstate Engineering, Inc.; Sparky Engquist, Road Supt. and Bruce Speich, Milnor arrived at the meeting. The Board proceeded to accept and review Requests for Proposals for Construction Engineering services on the following projects: CER-4103(059); CER-4110(058); CER-4110(059); CER-4135(054); CER-4110(064); CER-4125(063); CER-4125(064); CER-4125(065); CER-4129(058); SC-4129(060). Interstate Engineering, Inc., Wahpeton, ND, Kadrmas, Lee and Jackson, PC, Valley City, ND and Moore Engineering, Inc., West Fargo, ND were contacted for proposals. One proposal was received from Interstate Engineering, Inc. Accept the proposal. (Wyum/Waswick, unanimous)

Motion to adopt the following Resolution. (Wyum/Walstead. Roll Call vote. Aye: Wyum, Waswick, Walstead. Nay: Jacobson. Absent and not voting. Anderson. Resolution adopted 3-1-1.)

"Whereas, the bid in the amount of \$808,786.70 from Asphalt Surface Technologies Corp. received in the bid opening of May 17, 2013 for Project SC-4129(060) for Microsurfacing County # 12 from ND 13 south 6 miles to ND 11 was the low bid received. Whereas, this bid is considered reasonable. Now therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County to award to Asphalt Surface Technologies Corp. the contract for Project SC-4129(060) and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign said contract. It is further understood that the County shall reimburse NDDOT for

any payments made under this contract, which are not collectible from the Federal Highway Administration."

Sandy Hanson returned to the meeting and a discussion followed on the Herman Township Low Water Crossing Repair (S & D Crossing) -FEMA #STBRO3C. A lengthy discussion was held on whether to proceed with the scope of work as per FEMA. Total funds from FEMA are approximately \$91,435. Bids were opened on March 29 and a low bid was received from Johnson Excavation for \$100,969. After further discussion a motion to proceed with the FEMA project. (Wyum/Waswick. Roll call. Aye: Waswick, Walstead and Wyum. Nay: Jacobson. Absent and not voting: Anderson. Motion carried)

Bruce Speich delivered a thirty-day notice to downstream property owners regarding an application to install a subsurface drain in the E1/2 of E1/2 of Section 9-132-53. Bruce is asking permission to pump into the county road ditch. The outlet of this tile drain project will be in the northwest corner of this section just west of the curve on the paved Co. # 14 just east of DeLamere. Secondly, he is asking to install a new culvert under the county road just west of the curve to send the water straight north. The Board agreed that a hydraulic study was necessary in this area and directed Damon DeVillers, Interstate Engineering to proceed with the study to be reviewed at the June 4th meeting.

Travis Paeper, Sheriff, stopped by the meeting briefly to discuss laptop replacement for his department and a new Access Control and Video Surveillance Security System for the courthouse. The Courtroom Facilities Grant Committee will review the security system.

Approve Gaming Site Authorization to El Zagal Viking Patrol, Inc., Gwinner for Jerry Dill, dba Dilly's Bar and Grill, Stirum ND beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. (Waswick/Walstead, unanimous)

Approve an Application for a permit to conduct public dances for a period of 12 months at the Geneseo Hall. (Walstead/Waswick, unanimous)

Roger Zetocha, Stirum and Lucas Siemieniewski, Geneseo applied for the vacancy on the Sargent County Water Board following the death of Roger White. Motion to appoint Roger Zetocha to fill out the term. (Waswick/Wyum, unanimous)

Paperwork was reviewed regarding the appointment of a Public Administrator for Sargent County. Daniel D Narum, Acting Presiding Judge for The Honorable John E Greenwood, Presiding Judge for the Southeast Judicial District has appointed Jerry Waswick as the Public Administrator for Sargent County pursuant to terms of the North Dakota Century Code (NDCC) Chapter 11-21. That pursuant to Mr. Waswick's consent, he shall serve in the position of Public Administrator without compensation and Mr. Waswick shall be directed to exercise all the powers and responsibilities of a Public Administrator as set forth in NDCC.
