The Board proceeded to hold a public hearing on the County Budget and proposed tax levies for the ensuing year as advertised. About eighty interested tax payers were present for the budget hearing. Chairman Ardell Johnson stated that the public hearing is being held as required by Section 11-23 of the North Dakota Century Code and at this time any taxpayer will be heard in favor of or against the proposed budget.

The question was asked, why the County Commissioners had not included funds for setting up a County Nurse program in Sargent County after the straw vote held in November, 1976 had carried by about 400 votes.

The Commissioners stated that due to the increased costs of County Government and the number of bills passed by the 1977 legislature increasing costs and no increase in mills to cover the extra expenses they felt that they could not include a County Nurse in the Budget.

Several other persons voiced their opinion on the need for a County Nurse and there was also quite a number of persons who voiced their opinion as being opposed to securing the services of a nurse and that the County Commissioners were familiar with the finances of the County and they felt that the Commissioners were elected to govern and make policy for the County.

A compromise was suggested by the proponents asking for a county Nurse, if the Commissioners would allow \$3,500.00 in their budget for Public Health Clinics, etc for citizens of Sargent County, The Commissioners stated that they would consider their suggestion at the afternoon session. The public hearing adjourned at 11:30 A.M.

The Board met at 1:00 P.M. and the request of the proponents for a county nurse to include \$3,500.00 in the budget for public clinics was discussed.

Commissioner McLaen moved that the Commissioners deny the proponents request to finance Public Health Clinics, etc.

Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. On roll call vote all Commissioners voted "AYE". No one voted "NAY" and the motion was duly declared carried.
