





BE IT RESOLVED: By the Board of Sargent County Commissioners that this Board assembled this 18th day of July, 1978 deem it advisable and to be for the best interest of the County of Sargent, make application to the Bank of North Dakota under the terms and regulations of the North Dakota State Industrial Commissioner pursuant to Chapter 57-47 of the NDCC for a County Loan in the amount of \$100,000.00, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this County establish a general tax for a period of six years, or until such loan is repaid with interest, upon all the taxable property within the County, not to exceed three mills for any one year, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this County establish a "County Loan Fund" for the purpose of repaying said loan with interest in accordance with section 57-47-05 of the NDCC, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Sargent County States Attorney and the Sargent County Auditor take whatever other action is necessary to meet the requirements of the Chapter 57-47 of the NDCC, the Bank of North Dakota and the North Dakota State Industrial Commission.

Commissioner Cooper introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Resolved, that the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County to the extent that its authorization under the law to do so may be necessary, does hereby authorize the states attorney of this county to request the attorney general of North Dakota, or such assistant attorney general or special assistant attorney general as the attorney general may designate, to answer the complaint for the defense on behalf of this county the action brought in the District Court of Burleigh County under Section 57-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code by Soo Line Railroad Company as plaintiff against the State of North Dakota, acting by and through the State Board of Equalization, and this county and 31 other counties as defendants for refund of 1977 property taxes it paid in 1978 on its railroad operating property assessed by the State Board of Equalization; provided that expenditure of county funds is not authorized for payment for any services of the attorney general or his assistants or special assistants in the defense of said action.

Commissioner Johnson seconded the resolution. On roll call vote, all commissioners voted aye, no one voted no and the resolution was duly declared carried.

Thurman Heinertson and Kenneth Forester met with the Board in regards to purchasing a new ambulance. They were instructed to confer on selling the old ambulance and report the outcome at the next meeting.

Alton Crandall met with the Board regarding leafy spurge.
