The Board discussed delinquent contract for deeds, update on the courthouse project, speed limit signs at the fairgrounds and replacing the copy machine.

Approve Sunday Permit to Sell Alcoholic Beverages at Stir'Um Up Bar and Grill, Stirum, ND for twelve months for a fee of \$100. (Brockman/Wehlander, unanimous)

Approve Dance Permit to Geneseo Bar and Grill for public dances and wedding dances for twelve months. (Brockman/Walstead, unanimous)

Quentin Hoistad, Sargent County Park Board, met with the Board to discuss the well on the southwest side of Silver Lake. The sandpoint is plugged and there is no water for the new bathroom facility, which was just constructed. The Park Board does not have funding for replacement of the well. Karen and Quentin talked to SE Water Users and Manikowski Well Drilling for price estimates. Rural water would cost \$15,000 plus a monthly fee and overage. A new 4-inch well would cost \$6,000 unless the head is good and that can be used, the price would be less. Ray Brockman introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Silver Lake Park is the only recreational facility in Sargent County, and

WHEREAS, hundreds of people utilize the campgrounds each year, and

WHEREAS, a new restroom facility, which was just constructed on the southwest side was made fully accessible with indoor plumbing, including showers, and

WHEREAS, an existing well, which was dug in the 1960's has a plugged sandpoint and no longer works, and

WHEREAS, this new restroom facility cannot operate without a water supply and the Sargent County Park Board does not have funding to make repairs,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sargent County Board of Commissioners declare that an emergency exists and authorize the use of County Emergency funds to dig a new well on the southwest side of Silver Lake at a cost of \$6,000.

Mike Walstead seconded the resolution and motion carried unanimously.

Travis Paeper, Sheriff, met with the Board to discuss the bids on the DARE car. Two bids were received but Travis said he advertised the wrong year of the car and thought maybe it should be re-bid or offered to the auction in Fargo. Lyle Bopp will be contacted for his opinion. There were 26 applicants for the deputy matron job and interviews will be conducted on June 19. He would like to have someone hired and working on July 1.

Sandy Hanson met with the Board and discussed the Boy's State session. While there she met to discuss the mitigation plan for the county. FEMA gave the state permission for final approval on the plan. In order to comply with the deadline dates, an updated resolution is needed by this board. Sandy will prepare this for the next meeting. The draft mitigation plan will be sent in for review and the state will continue to work with the county. She also discussed the grant for mapping.

Appoint Jerome Brekke as a member-at-large on the SC JDA with a term expiring December 31, 2004. (Wehlander/Brockman, unanimous)

A statutory change in HB1262 from the 2003 Legislative Session addresses a county commissioner's term on an appointed board would end when his/her commission term ends, if the reason he/she was on the appointed board was by virtue of his/her commission seat. While a county commission could reappoint that person to another seat on a board, the vacant commissioner seat would have to be filled with a current county commissioner. W. E. Smith and Steven Wyum are serving the SC Job Development Authority as county commissioners and Ray Brockman as the Regional Planning representative. Reclassify W. E. Smith as a member-at-large, term ending December 31, 2003, Steve Wyum and Ray Brockman as county commission representatives, term ending December, 2006 and no one representing the Regional Planning council. (Wehlander/Walstead, unanimous)

Approve Agreement between Ransom County and Sargent County for Sharing SC Social Service Director. A copy is on file in the Director's Office. (Wehlander/Walstead, unanimous)

Reappoint Teresa Brummond, Havana to the SC Social Service Board for a three-year term. (Brockman/Walstead, unanimous)

Reappoint Jim Kleingarn, District 1 and Kent Johnson, District 5 to the Sargent County School Reorganization Board for a three-year term. (Walstead/Brockman, unanimous)

Sparky Engquist discussed several topics from the road department including trading in the Bobcat for a cost of \$1,000, summer help at \$7.50/hour, purchasing a roller for pavement and gravel and purchase of a 10-ton tiltbed trailer from state sale. He also plans to apply calcium magnesium on spots of road that need it and conduct bridge scour inspections. NDDOT provided a list of FAS road projects for 2004 for the Board to review before the October convention. Also discussed weight limits and speed law and County Road No. 2 job. The Board was also informed that NDDOT has removed Bridge 105-01 from the July bid letting to November 2003 because the State Historical Society would not give clearance necessary to proceed.

Meeting recessed at 12:10 p.m.

The commission reconvened at 1:15 with Don Wehlander absent.

Julie Hassebroek, Extension Service, met to request permission for out-of-state travel. She will attend a 4-H State Exchange with 10 county 4Hers to Albany, New York on July 5-12 and the National Envirothon Competition with the Sargent Central Envirothon Team to Emmitsburg, Maryland on July 25-August 1. The only cost to Sargent County would be travel to and from Forman to the Fargo airport. Approve travel. (Walstead/Brockman, unanimous)
