WHEREAS any complaints, unresolved disagreements, misunderstandings and/or other factors which might adversely affect the C.S.P. accomplishment will be referred to the State Civil Defense Director for his judgement, and

WHEREAS the completion of the C.S.P. will be executed as quickly as possible within the limitations of resources available:

Be it resolved by the duly elected governing officials of Sargent County that this body endorses and approves the initiation, development and completion of a Community Shelter Plan for Sargent County.


