THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT. MR. DAWSON.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

THE BOARD MET WITH TOWNSHIP AND VILLAGE BOARDS TO REVIEW AND APPROVE APPRAISALS OF COUNTY TAX DEED LAND AND LOTS.

REPRESENTATIVES WERE PRESENT FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BRAMPTON, DENVER, HARLEM AND SOUTH WEST TOWNSHIPS.

AFTER CONFERRING AT LENGTH WITH THESE BOARDS IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE FUTURE POLICY OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, IN REGARD TO TAX DEED LANDS WILL BE TO WITHHOLD FROM SALE, CERTAIN LAND WHICH WERE FOUND UNFIT FOR CULTIVATION AND BEST SUITED FOR GRAZING AND HAY LAND, BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COUNTY LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE AND THE VARIOUS BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN THE TOWNSHIPS AFFECTED. THESE LANDS TO BE OFFERED FOR LEASING FOR GRAZING OR HAY ONLY, AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 237, 1939 SESSION LAWS; EXCEPT THAT WHEREVER SHOWING IS MADE THAT LAND IS DESIRED FOR PROPER USE IN A FAMILY TYPE FARM BY THE PURCHASER, SALE MAY BE MADE AND APPROVED ON THAT BASIS.

THE BOARD DESIGNATED ALL LAND IN SOUTH WEST TOWNSHIP AND CERTAIN DESCRIPTIONS IN BRAMPTON, HARLEM AND MILNOR TOWNSHIPS AS FALLING IN THIS CLASSIFICATION.

COMMISSIONER SAEWERT INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:
 WHEREAS WHITE STONE HILL TOWNSHIP IS DESIROUS OF SECURING LOT 17, BLOCK 6, VILLAGE OF GWINNER FOR RECREATIONAL AND PARK PURPOSES, AND
 WHEREAS SARGENT COUNTY HOLDS TAX DEED TO THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PROPERTY,
 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT PURSUANT TO CHAP. 118, SESSION LAWS OF 1935, THAT THE UNPAID TAXES ON THIS LOT BE CANCELLED AND THAT THE LOT BE CONVEYED TO WHITE STONE HILL TOWNSHIP WITHOUT FURTHER CONSIDERATION, SAID LOT TO BE USED FOR RECREATIONAL OR PARK PURPOSES ONLY.
 MR. ANDERSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED AND THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED.

COMMISSIONER ANDERSON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION:
 WHEREAS RUTLAND VILLAGE IS DESIROUS OF SECURING FOR RECREATIONAL OR PARK PURPOSES, A TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED AS: "BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 24-130-55, UNPLATTED LANDS, VILLAGE OF RUTLAND, THENCE SOUTH TO NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 1, BLOCK 14, AUDITORS PLAT, THENCE WEST TO NORTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 10, AUDITORS PLAT; THENCE NORTH TO NORTHERN QUARTER LINE OF SE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 24, THENCE EAST TO POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 12.5 ACRES, MORE OR LESS;" AND
 WHEREAS SARGENT COUNTY HOLDS TAX DEED TO THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PROPERTY,
 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT PURSUANT TO CHAP. 118, SESSION LAWS OF 1935, THAT THE UNPAID TAXES ON THE ABOVE DESCRIBED LAND BE CANCELLED AND THAT THE SAID LAND BE CONVEYED TO THE VILLAGE OF RUTLAND WITHOUT FURTHER CONSIDERATION, SAID LAND TO BE USED FOR RECREATIONAL OR PARK PURPOSES ONLY.
 COMMISSIONER WYUM SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

WHEREAS IT IS DESIRABLE AND IN THE BEST PUBLIC INTEREST AND WELFARE THAT A RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT BE SECURED ALONG THE COUNTY HIGHWAY ADJACENT TO THIS PROPERTY,
