



Commissioner Anderson introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Whereas, it is desired by the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County, North Dakota to provide for the construction of Federal Aid Project No. OS 41(1) in Sargent County, beginning at station 1+00 a point 100 feet No. of the SW Corner of Section 22 T. 132 R. 55 W. and ending at station 81+00 a point 2828 feet No. of the NW Cor. of Section 22 T. 132 R. 55 W. Type of improvement - Bituminous Surfacing. Total length approximately 1.515 miles and that the Chairman and the County Auditor be authorized and directed to sign an agreement for construction and maintenance of said project.

WHEREAS, The aforementioned limitation would end all hopes of a State Revenue Sharing program to assist local governments; and

WHEREAS, Certain local services would suffer reductions in staff, facilities and programs if there were any kind of cutback in this county's financial status; and

WHEREAS, Any kind of cutback in state or federal money channeled into this county would have to be replaced by an increase in the inequitable property tax to maintain the aforementioned programs; and,

WHEREAS, The maintenance of the present welfare, education and health services at their present level is essential to insure all citizens of Sargent County that kind of life that North Dakotan's have enjoyed for years; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That we, The Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County oppose the measure in the September 1976 Primary Election to limit state general fund expenditures to \$332 million, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By this Board of County Commissioners, that all citizens and constituents of Sargent County are urged to oppose the limitation on general fund expenditures for the preceding reasons, and are urged to vote "NO" on measure NO. 1 on the September primary ballot.

Commissioner Cooper seconded the resolution. On roll call vote, Commissioners Anderson, Cooper, Johnson, McLaen and Orth voted "AYE". No one voted "NAY" and the resolution was duly declared carried and adopted.
