The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Bill Anderson, Mike Walstead, Steve Wyum, Maurice Orn and Jerry Waswick. Absent none.

Approve June 6, 2006 minutes as corrected. (Wyum/Anderson, unanimous) Board members received a copy of the May 2006 financial report.

The Board placed a call to Mike Manstrom, Dougherty & Company LLC to discuss the timeframe for issuance of the \$700,000 bond issue. The Bond Issue was voted on at the Primary Election and passed with 69% in favor. Mr. Manstrom will prepare payment schedules for the Board to review and will meet with them on July 5th.

Board members discussed the current Bereavement Leave policy. Motion made to modify language in Section 309 of SC Personnel Policy regarding bereavement leave. Motion withdrawn pending receipt of additional information. (Orn/Wyum. Motion withdrawn)

Lyle Bopp arrived at the meeting.

Wendy Jacobson, Social Service Director introduced new contract staff person, Beth LeQuire, Family Focus Social Worker. The Board extended a welcome to Ms. LeQuire. Board members discussed the Social Service Board position, which expires on June 30, 2006. Teresa Brummond, Havana currently holds said position and Steve Juszczak, Milnor expressed an interest in an appointment. Motion to reappoint Teresa Brummond to another three-year term. (Walstead/Orn, unanimous) Mrs. Jacobson also discussed the Child Support Enforcement Interagency Cooperative Agreement between the Dept. of Human Services, Grand Forks Regional Child Support Unit, the fifty-three county social service boards, and the eight regional child support units. The agreement specifies the purpose, term, duties, functions and responsibilities, as well as compensation, performance standards, compliance, maintenance of records, assignment, integration and modification, authority to enter agreement and personnel. Approve cooperative agreement presented and that Sargent County Commission authorizes adoption by Region 5 Child Support Enforcement Unit to execute the agreement on behalf of Region 5 and Sargent County. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)

Discussed Section 309 of the Sargent County Personnel Policy and moved to redefine the immediate family definition as follows: The employer defines "immediate family" as the employee's spouse, parent (natural, adoptive, foster or stepparent), child (natural, adoptive, foster or stepchild) and child's spouse, sibling and sibling's spouse, grandparents or grandchildren. The employee's spouse's parent, child or sibling is also included in the definition of "immediate family". (Orn/Wyum, unanimous)

Lyle Bopp informed the Board that he has made a clarification on Colleen Sundquist and Sandy Hanson's allowable vacation time and submitted to the Auditor's Office for implementation.

Steve Wyum presented a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate of the Lake Traverse Reservation (Tribe) and Sargent County clarifying the maintenance for public roadways designated as Indian Reservation Roads (IRR), including 12.5 miles of County 5, 7.6 miles of County 7 and 8.9 miles of County 12. The Bureau of Indian Affairs provides funding for the construction and improvement of public roadways serving the Indian communities and the Tribe may engage in the construction or improvement of IRR from time to time. Sargent County is responsible for maintaining all public roadways and right-of-ways within the county's jurisdiction. It is understood that should the Tribe construct one or more of the following IRR routes, Sargent County agrees to maintain such routes as prescribed by law. The Board placed a call to NDDOT to discuss the MOU pro's and con's. Table a decision until further date.

Sparky Engquist, road supervisor updated Board members on road department projects. He highlighted gravel project expenditures and pavement projects.

Lee Ann Even, Cogswell City Mayor, met with the Board to discuss a property in Cogswell that has delinquent taxes. Board members suggested that the City of Cogswell proceed with notification to the landowner and cleanup of the property.

Rep. Bill Amerman, District 26 Democratic-NPL met to discuss the loss of funding in the Federal Aid System road allocation. Rep. Amerman would like to draft a letter to the Legislative Interim Committee to discuss the loss of funding and see if a public forum can be scheduled to present the hardships that this shortfall will cause to county government. NDDOT would be invited to attend as well as all counties affected. The commission agreed that Bill Anderson, Chairman, SE County

Commissioner's Association, will invite NDDOT representatives to attend the next meeting in Fullerton on July 5. Local legislators will also be invited.
