Members of the Sargent County Fairboard met with the Board to discuss the 2003 fair, which is scheduled for August 29, 30, 31 and September 1 and repairs needed to the buildings. The fence west of the grandstand is being replaced and discussed replacing windows on the Auditorium. Estimates will be requested and presented to the Board.

Cindy Leinen, Forman Ambulance reported that she contacted members of the Glyndon, MN Rescue Service and they are interested in helping the squad during vacations scheduled by the local ambulance personnel. The county insurance agent will be contacted about liability and States Attorney will send a letter to the squad.

Tammy Schillinger, Parole and Probation Supervisor met with the Board to present the 2003-2004 Joint Powers Agreement between Sargent County and Dept. of Corrections and Rehabilitation for \$300 per month. Approve continuation of the agreement. (Brockman/Wehlander, unanimous)

Doug Staller, Manager, Tewaukon National Wildlife Refuge arrived at the meeting to present the 2003 Refuge Revenue Sharing check for \$18,057 (48% of entitlement, which is less than previous years but there are 2 bills requesting the Senate to approve full funding). Jennifer Rothhouse, Refuge Assistant reported on weed control, haying program, the purple loose strife replacement program, wildfire control and dove banding project. Doug reported on other issues including carp removal from the lake, County # 12 road project and replacement of Bridge Nos. 129-19 and 133-21.

Reviewed building insurance on county property. Instructed Auditor to contact ND State Fire & Tornado Fund about increasing the County Highway Shop.

Gina Hillestad, Treasurer, provided information on pledge of assets. Approve pledge of assets as in accordance with law. Sargent County Bank is \$3,610,000 and First National Insurance Bank is \$1,075,000. (Wehlander/Wyum, unanimous)

Discussed courthouse tuckpointing project and selected colors for renovation improvements.

Jerry Dill, Verner Township Chairman and Sparky Engquist met with the Board to discuss 2 miles of road (between Section 19/30 and 20/29). Verner Township would like to turn over those 2 miles to the county. They cannot continue to maintain these two miles because of budget restraints. The county suggested exchanging the 2 miles between Section 6/7 and 5/8 for these two miles. The township does not want the responsibility of either roadway. Jerry asked about the township gravelling the road and the county providing maintenance and snow removal. Sparky said this is occasionally being done now. Instructed Sparky to install a traffic counter on this roadway and check in two weeks.

Sparky Engquist reviewed the 2003 gravel projects, trade-in of the Bobcat, proceeding with County No. 2 project and bidding on the local level and speed limit and weight limit policy. Adopt the Speed Limit and Weight Limit policy for roads as prepared and discussed at the recent Five County meeting. Sargent, Ransom, LaMoure and Dickey County will comply with this policy. Copies will be available at the county road supervisor's office, elevators and the sheriff's office. (Wehlander/Walstead, unanimous) Discussed making a parking lot on the north edge of the fairgrounds and receiving the landowners written consent to proceed. Courthouse parking was discussed and agreed that the area west of the courthouse could be filled in to allow more parking. Sparky will work with Doc Nelson.
