The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 a.m. with the following members present: W.E. Smith, Karen Anderson, Steve Wyum, Ray Brockman and Donald Wehlander. Absent none.

Lyle Bopp arrived to assist the Board in reviewing the proposed revisions to the county personnel policy. States Attorney Bopp will make all changes as the Board has discussed and the Board will review prior to final adoption.

Roger Zetocha, Sandy Hanson, Donna Eklund and Dennis Goltz met with the Board on Fairboard concerns. They discussed the new restroom/concession facility and its use by the Forman Park Board. The Park Board contributed \$1,000 of their funds and the Ashley Lions Club donated another \$500. Forman City also donated \$1,000 for the facility. The Park Board will complete the concession area and the building will be owned and insured by the county. Roger Zetocha reported that there is a carnival scheduled for the 2002 fair. Dennis Goltz and Kristine Askerooth are new board members and Donna Eklund is the new secretary-treasurer. The Board is working on a Bull-a-rama for the 2002 fair instead of Saturday music. The date of the county fair was discussed and decided that this is the best date that works for our area and asked for the commissioner's support to continue on Labor Day weekend.

Steve Lies, city attorney, Wahpeton, ND arrived at the meeting to discuss the annexation of land into Gwinner City regarding the landfill.

Jack Lalor, Tewaukon Refuge presented the Refuge Revenue Sharing check, which is only 51% of the total allocated. State law mandates 75% of the monies to the schools and 25% to the townships. Jack reported on spraying this summer for thistle. He also discussed the goose depredation program and that the ND Game and Fish is issuing permits to those who have a serious problem. To date only five applications have been received by NDGF.

Chuck Gates met with the Board to present the Underage Drinking Contract for \$1,300 for 7/2002-5/2003, which was signed by the Chairman. Chuck asked about a county website and we have a domain name but to register it would cost \$50. NDACo would host the site for a monthly fee of \$25 with a setup fee of approximately \$1600. Information would contain pictures of different county areas, activities being held in the county, board minutes, tax sale information, county history, warrants and monthly reports from the Sheriff's Office. Approve technology coordinator to facilitate the establishment of a website for Sargent County. (Wyum/Anderson, unanimous)

Gina Hillestad met with the Board to present the job classification for the Tobacco Prevention coordinator through the county health department. Establish the position of tobacco prevention coordinator at Grade 9 based on MAXIMUS classification subject to clarification. (Wyum/Smith, unanimous)

Approve transfer of \$29,771.38 from General Fund/Estate Taxes to Capital Improvements. (Wehlander/Wyum, unanimous)

Karen Anderson reported that the windows in the dome need glazing to protect the inside of the dome and the murals from rain and other elements. Authorize repairs and maintenance to the windows.

Approve addition of omitted property located in Sublot 1-19-131-55 for \$55,700 true and full value for 2002. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)

Ron Narum, Mayor, City of Rutland, requested the county to sell the city some property located between the county shop and the city/township shop in Rutland. The city wants to add on to their shop $(30'\times54')$ and the county would still retain street access. They would like to obtain a $50'\times207'$ parcel. Approve sale to City of Rutland/Rutland Township for \$250 plus deed preparation and recording. (Smith/Anderson, unanimous)

Approve July 2 and 6, 2002 minutes as corrected. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)

The first meeting in October occurs the same date as the state convention. Chairman Brockman approved changing the October meeting dates to October 8 and 22, 2002.

Sparky Engquist met with the Board to request cost share for a culvert for Verner Township. Two 36-inch \times 42-foot culverts are needed to replace two existing 24-inch culverts located between 25-26/131/58. The Water Board met and approved sizing and 1/3 cost share. Approve 1/3 cost share for the county and the township shall pay 1/3 plus installation. (Smith/Anderson, unanimous)

Sparky reported on repairs to Bergh-McLaen Waterway. He also reviewed the FAS projects for 2003-2005. The Board made some adjustment and pending system change on SC-4111(063), they will meet with NDDOT at state convention to discuss the projects.

Approve payment of the following bills and July payroll in the sum of \$77,272.16. (Smith/Wehlander, unanimous)
