Jerry Waswick arrived at this time.

Motion to approve the June financial statement. (Wyum/Waswick, unanimous)]

Mike Walstead reported that he had attended the July 8 meeting of the Milnor City Council, and that Milnor City had agreed to pay ½ of the total cost of the Main Street/County # 10 repairs in Milnor City. Mike will be attending a pre-construction conference for the project. Mike also reported that he had been contacted by a Water Board member regarding replacing the culvert in the legal drain that passes through Milnor City which crosses Main Street/County #10. The Water Board is obligated to pay 60% of the expense and the county 40%, pursuant to State law.

The Board discussed Bridge 129-24.1 located between Section 21 and 22-129-54 LTL in Tewaukon Township. Interstate Engineering Inc. prepared a hydraulic study and presented two options for replacing this bridge. The Board will ask Damon DeVillers to prepare cost estimates for these two options for the Board to consider at the next meeting.

Damon DeVillers, Interstate Engineering, Inc. and Sparky Engquist, Road Supt. met with the Board to discuss road projects. Damon presented Preliminary Engineering Services Agreement for CER-4111(069) – 0.5 miles North of ND 11 by Cogswell on SC # 4 and CER-4129(059) – 5 miles South of Cayuga on SC # 12. Motion to approve the agreements (Wyum/Waswick, unanimous)

Damon explained the non-oil producing county project selection criteria guide regarding House Bill 1358 of the 63rd Legislative Assembly which has provided \$280.0 Million for the 53 counties in North Dakota for 2013-2015 Biennium. Approximately \$2.7 million of this amount is projected for allocation to Sargent County. The funding may be used for Ninety (90%) of the cost of the approved project(s) not to exceed the funding available for that county. The Board will prepare a list of projects for consideration in the next biennium.

Bruce Speich, DeLamere met with the Board to inquire about the schedule for the culvert boring through County # 14. The location of this site is a crossing on Co. # 14 on the east side of Section 9 in Hall Township. He also requested permission to complete another boring, at his own expense, to extend the drain tile for a tile field drainage system through County #14 so the water may be discharged on land that he owns. Mr. Speich will complete the county road right-of-way application for the roadbed boring project.

David Lunneborg, Milnor met with the Board to discuss several stream crossing culverts in Crooked Creek, located on Shuman Township roadways. He is concerned about the additional water that will be flowing through the new reinforced concrete box culverts soon to be installed on Crooked Creek where it crosses County #1 and County #10 after it leaves Buffalo Lake. He is concerned that the existing culverts through the Township road grades downstream will not be capable of handling the water properly. The township must complete hydraulic studies on each crossing to be certain that any proposed changes in culvert size through the Township roads meet the statutory minimum standards for Stream Crossings. The Water Board and county may cost share on thirty-six (36) inch culverts or larger if the hydraulic study is completed, however, there is no legal obligation for either the Water

Board or the County Road Department to cost share with the Township. The best option would be to establish a legal drain and implement a comprehensive water resource management plan in this area.

Sandy Hanson, Tax Director, presented four applications for tax abatements, one omitted property and two inundated land applications for consideration by this Board. Gary and Abbi Myers, Gwinner were present and had filed an Application for Abatement of Taxes on Parcel 31-9724000, situated in the City of Gwinner's Renaissance Zone. The ND Dept of Commerce approved a property tax exemption for the rehabilitation of their home at 511 5th St NW in Gwinner for July 2012 through June 2017. The Myers are asking for a refund of their 2012 taxes which was approved by Gwinner City. Concur with the city. (Anderson/Waswick, unanimous). Jason Kottke, Milnor filed an Application for Abatement of Taxes for 2012 on Parcel 06-2413000 stating that 75 acres of his land was assessed both as residential and agricultural and request that only 5 acres be assessed as residential and the remaining 70 as agricultural. Hall Township approved the request. Motion to concur with Hall Township. (Walstead/Waswick, unanimous). Dennis Goltz, Havana filed an Application for Abatement of Taxes on Parcel 22-6521001 for the years of 2011 and 2012 for the reason that the value of a house and other structures was placed on the wrong parcel. Sandy Hanson has visited with Mr. Goltz and reported that the newly appraised home value will be placed on Parcel 22-6521000 which is owned by Jason Goltz. The correct values will be calculated based on the new soils values for 2012 and the new residential appraisal. Weber Township approved the request. Motion to concur with the Weber Township Board. (Wyum/Anderson, unanimous)

Two applications were received for Classification as Inundated Agricultural Land. The Board proceeded to consider each application as follows: Parcel 22-6553000 for 10.00 acres and Parcel 22-6392000 for 37.95 acres from Milton and Danene McLaen. Approve both parcels as according to Tax Director Hanson they meet the criteria for inundated lands. (Wyum/Waswick, unanimous). Parcels 20-6097000 for 17.12 acres; Parcel 20-6102000 for 50.86 acres; Parcel 20-6117000 for 21.97 acres; Parcel 20-6149000 for 109.54 acres and Parcel 20-6159000 for 36.08 acres from Gerald and Judith Ringdahl. Approve all parcels as according to Tax Director Hanson they meet the criteria for inundated lands. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous)

Approve a Sargent County Road Permit to Jerry's Backhoe Service to bore a three inch hole under 89th St SE in Section 27-131-58 (County #2) for the installation of a rural water line, as per conditions set forth in the county permit. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous)

Damon DeVillers, Interstate Engineering, Inc. presented proposals to supply engineering services for several projects. The Board proceeded to accept and review Requests for Proposals for Construction Engineering services on the following projects: CER-4110(062); CER-4110(063); CER-4125(062); CER-4118(054). Interstate Engineering, Inc., Wahpeton, ND, Kadrmas, Lee and Jackson, PC, Valley City, ND and Moore Engineering, Inc., West Fargo, ND were contacted for proposals. One proposal was received from Interstate Engineering, Inc. Accept the proposal. (Anderson/Wyum, unanimous)

The Board reviewed a request from NDACo to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with the other 52 Counties and NDACo for Public Administrator Support Services.

Authorize the Chairman and County Auditor to sign and execute any forthcoming documents regarding the North Dakota Federal Lands Access Program (NDFLAP) 142 SE (1) – Breker Bridge Replacement. This bridge is located in Tewaukon Township, where 142nd AV SE crosses the Wild Rice River. (Walstead/Wyum, unanimous)

The Board recessed at 12:00 noon for lunch.

The Board reconvened at 1:00 p.m.

Lisa Dawson, Sargent County Extension Office provided budget numbers to increase the support staff hours in that department from 3 days a week to 4 days a week. The cost to increase the hours for this position would be approximately \$2,500 through 2013. Motion to approve this increase on an interim basis for the balance of 2013 and review the Extension budget for 2014 at the time of budget hearings. (Wyum/Waswick, unanimous)

Travis Paeper, Sheriff met with the Board to ask permission to remodel the Sheriff's front office to include new carpet, new cabinetry, countertop, pony wall and door. Approximate cost of the project is \$12,000. After further discussion, the Board asked Sheriff Paeper to research funding sources and report to the Board on August 6th on the source of the funds that the Sheriff proposes to utilize for this project.

The Board attended a Pre-Construction Conference with Riley Brothers Construction Co. of Morris MN, conducted by Damon DeVillers, Engineer, Interstate Engineering for the following projects:
