The Board of Review and Equalization was called to order by the Chairman, Commissioner Orth with all members present.

The Board proceeded to review the assessment of Farm Lands, City Lots and Structures in the various taxing districts.

A.T. BAKKEGARD AND Ralph Kiefer met with the Board in regards to assessment of Farm Lands in Tewaukon Twp.

Commissioner Bruns moved that the following changes be made on Farm Lands in Tewaukon Township
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1-129-54 LTL, Decrease \$1174.00 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2-129-54 LTL, Decrease \$664.00
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2-129-54 LTL, Decrease \$ 711.00 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12-129-54 LTL, Decrease \$584.00
Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. All members voted "AYE" and the motion carried.

The Board proceeded to compare the assessment of Farm Lands between Townships

After checking the assessed valuations on the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21-132-53 due to a complaint made by the owner, the assessments were left as approved by the Hall Township Board of Equalization.

Commissioner Chesley moved that the assessment of all bulk plants owned by American Oil Co. in the Cities of Gwinner, DeLamere, Stirum and Havana be increased 15 % and that the assessment of all bulk plants owned by the American Oil Co. be lowered as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 11-07-02 of the North Dakota Century Code requires that the County Redistricting Board meet after Official Publication of each Federal Census to redistrict County Commissioner Districts based on population, so that each Commissioner District does not vary more than 10 % of the average for each Commissioner.


WHEREAS, at a public hearing held on July 22nd, 1971 at the Courthouse in Forman, North Dakota, at 8:30 P.M. the consensus of the persons present at said hearing was that the County be divided into districts as nearly equal in population as practicable, and that each Commissioner elected must reside in the district and be elected at large as provided for in Section 11-07-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County, North Dakota, hereby direct the Sargent County Redistricting Board to divide the County into Commissioner Districts and that all Commissioners be elected at large as provided for in Section 11-07-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Commissioner Bruns seconded the resolution. On roll call vote all Commissioners voted "AYE" and the motion was duly declared carried and adopted.
