Whereas, it is desired by the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent, North Dakota to provide for the construction of Federal Aid Secondary Projects CS 31(3) and CS 66(3) Base, Bituminous Surfacing on a County Road from Crete North and from State Highway 11 North of Rutland North - 4.757 miles.

Therefore be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County, North Dakota that the Chairman and the County Auditor be authorized and directed to sign a construction agreement with the State Highway Department for the above named projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said program be submitted to the electors of Sargent County, along with the question of levying a tax of not to exceed Ten (10) Mills annually until the program is completed, upon the net taxable assessed valuation of all the property in the County for the completion of said program by matching from the proceeds tax, Federal Funds available for Federal Aid, secondary and feeder roads, farm to market roads and all roads as provided for under Public Law 769, 81st Congress or future Federal Aid Highway Acts of a similar character, and that the proceeds in excess of the amount needed to match Federal Funds in any year be made available to the County for providing paved or any other type of road surfacing on roads included in the above program, all in conformity with Section 57-15-06.3 of the North Dakota Century Code; and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that said question shall be submitted to the Electors at the Primary Election to be held September 1st, 1970, and that the County Auditor be authorized and instructed to place said question on the Ballot.


