
Lowell Kraig met with the Board in regard to installing an approach to his property, the Sec. 13-129-55. The Board agreed to install the approach.

The resolution was seconded by Commissioner Manikowski. On roll call vote all commissioners voted aye. Motion carried.





Commissioner Anderson seconded the resolution. On roll call vote all commissioners voted aye and the resolution was duly declared carried and adopted.


