The Board, Toyne's and Bopp went out to the Toyne farm and measured the area which Mr. Toyne is interested in buying. An amount will be placed on this parcel and Mr. Toyne will be given an opportunity to buy it.

Commissioner Orth moved that the Board approve payment of the Primary Election Cost Bills in the amount of \$2,811.65. Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.

Arne Norman, Supt., Globe Gazette Printing Co., answered questions from the Board pertaining to the printing cost bill for the Primary Election.

Commissioner Anderson moved that the Board approve an additional \$50.00 assessment to the Southeast County Commissioner's Association for the 1980-1981 year. Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.


The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

Commissioner Anderson made a motion that the Board approve the October payroll in the sum of \$30,427.09. Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.

Clifford Moore, Moore Engineering, Maynard Lien and James Bosse, Sargent County Water Management Board met with the Commissioners to discuss the possibility of cleaning out Sargent County Drain # 7 now known as Sargent County Water Channel Improvement District # 1.

Commissioner Anderson moved that the Board approve the request from the Sargent County Water Management Board to proceed with the plans for cleaning out and restoring said Drain to its original state. Commissioner Orth seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.

The Board proceeded to appraise County Lands and City Lots which have been forfeited to the County for nonpayment of taxes and on motion said appraisals were approved in the amounts shown on a list which will be posted at the front door of the Courthouse November 3, 1980 according to law and the time of hearing objections to the minimum sales price agreed upon was set at 10:00 a.m. November 4, 1980.

Commissioner Manikowski moved that the Auditor instruct Sargent County Precinct Number 13 (Rutland City, Ransom and Rutland Townships) that the new polling place will be located in the Community Room of the Sargent County Bank, Rutland, ND. Said move to be effective for the 1980 General Election. Commissioner Orth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Al Clark, Ultieg Engineers, discussed the plans for a bridge replacement. Commissioner Orth made a motion that Mr. Clark proceed with the Bridge Replacement Program on CBRS 4135 (51) - 135-08 located on the Wild Rice River 6 miles North of Geneseo. The replacement of said bridge will be with matching monies from the Federal Government. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.

A letter from Soo Line Railroad Company was read by the Board. Commissioner Orth moved that the refund of \$7,462.56 be granted to this company. Said refund is due to a law suit in which five years taxes have been paid under protest in thirty-two counties in North Dakota. The balance, \$14,389.90 will be apportioned to the various taxing districts in Sargent County. Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion. Unanimously carried.

Commissioner Manikowski moved that the following sales of County Tax Deed Property be approved and deeds issued to purchaser: Lots 2, 3 & 4, Block 5, Weber's Addition and Lot 10, Block 4, Williamson's Second Addition, City of Havana to Lester L. Larson, Box 1152 Sioux Falls, SD. Commissioner Orth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Orth made a motion to appoint S. S. Cooper as a member of the General Election Canvassing Board. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Motion carried.


Commissioner Cooper made a motion that the Courthouse be closed on December 26, 1980. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
