COMMISSIONER BOPP SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.



COMMISSIONER LEE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

DARWIN LEE MET WITH THE BOARD IN REGARDS TO SECURING THE POSITION AS COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT.
COMMISSIONER BRUNS MOVED THAT DARWIN LEE BE HIRED TO SERVE SARGENT COUNTY AS COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT.
COMMISSIONER BOPP SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.
