The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion approved as read.

Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Orth seconded the motion to approve the payments to the various election officials for the Primary Election held September 5, 1978 in the amount of \$1,151.90. Motion carried.

After discussion on moving buildings in Sargent County, it was decided that all residents in Sargent County prior to moving any buildings on county roads shall obtain a moving permit from the County Auditor. The fee for the permit shall be \$2.00.

The County Auditor was instructed to call for sealed bids in the Official Newspaper for the purchase of one new ambulance for Sargent County. Bids to be opened October 24, 1978 at 10:30 a.m. Specifications for said bid may be obtained by writing or calling the County Auditor's Office.

Commissioner Cooper moved that the following sale of County Tax Deed property be approved and deed issued to purchaser: Lot 27 and M 10 feet of Lot 30 and Lots 31 and 32, Block 19, City of Milnor to Randall Asche, Milnor, North Dakota. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Johnson moved that the DeLamere Community Club be issued gambling permit No. 6 for November, 1978 through April, 1979.

Commissioner Orth seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Cooper moved that the Board adjourn to October 3, 1978 at 9:00 a.m.

The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion approved as read.

Robert Lotver and Brent Higdon from the Milnor Ambulance Squad met with the Board to discuss the possibility of obtaining a new ambulance for the Milnor Squad. After discussion Mr. Lotver and Mr. Higdon were instructed to talk to Clarence Olson at the Division of Emergency Health Services in Bismarck and to let them know what the results were.

Curtis Wristag, Sargent County Civil Defense Director met to discuss the Annual Civil Defense Program which will take place during the month of October. They would like each Director to sponsor a Nuclear Table Top Exercise with persons in the county, and answer questions and discuss any problems which might arise from a disaster such as this. October 24, 1978 at 7:30 p.m. was the date chosen for Sargent County's program. This will be held at the Courthouse in Forman.

Commissioner Johnson introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Whereas, the people of Sargent County will be given an opportunity to vote on a state revenue sharing program in the next general election, and;

Whereas, at the same time, the state legislature continues to mandate more programs for local government, yet seldom appropriates any money to pay for their cost, and;

Whereas, the local property tax system can be relied upon for supporting local government at the service level demand by the people of this county, and;

Whereas, the people of Sargent County are deserving of the benefits that a state revenue sharing program can provide. Benefits which as property tax relief, better localized services and better local self government.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved: That the Sargent County Board of Commissioners go on record as supporting the initiated revenue sharing measure and further urge all Sargent County voters to vote yes on MEASURE #1 in the November general election.

Commissioner Anderson seconded the resolution. On roll call vote all commissioners voted "AYE", no one voted "NO" and the resolution was duly declared carried and adopted.

Commissioner Johnson moved that the application for Beer and Liquor License submitted by Mary Ann Opitz on Lots 20 and 21, Block 2, Village of Veda be approved and licenses issued for same.

Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion and same carried.

The Auditor was instructed to send notices to the seven townships in the county which the county provides blading and plowing of roads, that effective January 1, 1979, the services will be discontinued. Due to the increasing cost of fuel, parts, etc. and the fact that the machinery is wearing out was the reason for this decision.



Commissioner Orth moved that the Board approve the Satisfaction and Discharge of Trust Mortgage on said properties.


Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Cooper seconded the motion and same carried.


