Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that the Board approve Games of Chance Permit No. 85-09 to the Dakota Rose Homemakers for a raffle on October 26, 1985 at Forman City Hall. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and same carried.



The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

Commissioner Manikowski moved that the minutes be approved as read. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Orville Nelson, Tax Director, met with the Board to discuss two classes offered for assessors on appraisals and tax certification. Commissioner Johnson moved that the Board approve his attendance at these courses beginning October 21 in Bismarck. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Sandy Seth and Lois Gehring, Community Action Agency, were seeking transportation for commodities which Sargent County will receive September 27. Commissioner Manikowski moved that the Board allocate transportation for the 9-27 commodities from Fargo to Cogswell. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved to publish the notice regarding Cutting Weeds and Grasses on County and Township Highways on Sept. 11 and 18. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Dave Potter and Gary Erickson, Tewaukon National Wildlife Refuge, met briefly with the Board to discuss bridges, DU projects and activities at the refuge.

Stanley Armer, Squad Leader, Forman Ambulance, was seeking approval from the Board to increase the pay to ambulance personnel. He proposed an increase of \$25 per week to carry the beeper and \$7.50/hour during a loaded run. He estimates these amounts would increase that budget item to \$16,900 per year. The Board discussed the present balance in the ambulance fund and suggested that Mr. Armer meet with the ambulance squad regarding this and the proposed increase in pay. The Board also agreed to prepare an article for the paper seeking more ambulance personnel. A revised budget will be presented to the Board on September 17.

Derwood Ellestad, Road Foreman, presented a list of all bridges that had been posted in Sargent County. Said bridges were inspected in April, 1985 and Sargent County was advised to post all bridges as per the state specifications or be ineligible for the use of any Federal Aid Bridge Replacement Funds. The list of bridges was mailed to the Secondary Roads Dept.

Lyle Bopp, States Attorney, reviewed a Temporary Construction Easement for CBRS 4129 (52). The bridge is located 2 miles south of Cayuga and will be bid in November, 1985. Catherine F. Lawrence, Cayuga, was contacted regarding signing the easement and she verbally approved her acceptance. The State Highway Dept. will review the easements this month.

Elda Bigelow, Social Service employee, met with the Board regarding some information published in the Commissioner's proceedings of a previous meeting. The Board read Mrs. Bigelow a letter from them offering their apologies to that Dept.

The Board reviewed the Sargent County Social Service General Assistance policy and Commissioner Manikowski moved to accept said policy. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and same carried. A copy is on file in the Auditor's Office.

The Board proceeded to review the preliminary budgets submitted by the various departments in the county.

The following bills were audited. Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that the bills be paid. Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion and same carried.

The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with Commissioner Manikowski and Commissioner Johnson absent.

Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that the minutes be approved as distributed. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Loren Daede and Clyde Mallory, Interstate Engineering, met with the Board to discuss the progress on the paving projects north and south of Rutland. There is concern from the taxpayers on the inslope, backslope, rocks and sod in the ditches, rough spots, approaches and striping. The engineers will be sending a letter to the contractor listing the areas that were discussed. The slope near Brummonds is being worked on and the county may be obligated to assist with the fencing. A letter will be sent to Brummond informing him of the amount that was bid for water on the south project. The Board agreed that county forces are responsible for sod and rock removal on the north portion. The south portion shall be the responsibility of the contractor. If he wishes the county to do the work, he should contact the Board and make arrangements. Interstate Engineering is willing to come down and accompany the county road superintendent to stake the areas that need additional work. The Board also discussed the recommendation on striping that has been completed. Mr. Daede reported that 84.4 ton of mix and 5.57 ton of AC were used to patch the water line trench in Rutland City. Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that a bill be sent to the city for \$2,044.76. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Sharon Pramhus, Superior Telephone Systems, Inc., presented a telephone proposal to the Board for their consideration. She also demonstrated the system to the Board and some of the department heads. No decision was made.

Commissioner Mag Anderson moved that the Board approve the September payroll for \$39,625.03. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried unanimously.

The 1986 Directory Service was discussed and moved to wait until 1987 to order.

Commissioner Mag Anderson moved to approve Games of Chance Permit No. 85-10 to DeLamere Community Hall Ass'n. for a raffle and bingo on 11-2-85 at the DeLamere Community Hall. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Chairman Smith reported that a caterpillar road grader is being repaired in Fargo. The cost to repair said machine will be approximately \$3,100 plus freight.

Fred Wittmann, Milnor Ambulance Squad, submitted the 1986 budget and met with the Board regarding reimbursement for the volunteers.

Henry Wisness, Secondary Roads Engineer, sent a letter informing the Board of upcoming bridge replacement projects. He advised the Board to prepare No. 130-16 for the 1987 program. The Board moved to send a letter to that department requesting that both 130-16 and 130-17 be considered for 1986 but if matching monies are not available, then the 1987 schedule would be more cost effective for Sargent County.

The Board discussed a request for a delegate to serve on the ND State Fair Ass'n. No appointment was made.

A letter was received from DMG, a professional accounting firm, to offer assistance in preparing a cost allocation plan to recover additional funds for the county. The Board was not interested in pursuing this plan.

The following bill was audited. Commissioner Mag Anderson moved to pay the bill. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried unanimously.







The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

Commissioner Manikowski moved that the minutes be approved as read. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and same carried.

Don Kadoun presented an Application for Special Permit to Sell Alcoholic Beverages at a Special Event to the Board. Said application was for the Trading Post, Stirum, ND, to sell beverages at a Fireman's Ball on October 25, 1985 in Stirum. Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that the permit be approved. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried. Mr. Kadoun also discussed the possibility of installing a speed bump in Stirum to slow down the traffic. No decision was made.

The State Library sent a letter requesting \$2,076.00 from Sargent County to continue the mailings from that department to residents in the county. Commissioner Manikowski moved that said request be denied. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Mr. and Mrs. William Seyer met with the Board in regards to the abatement filed on a parcel in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 17-131-58. They were requesting a commercial assessment be removed as it was no longer used for the initial intent. Commissioner Johnson moved that the Board approve an abatement of taxes for 1983 and 1984 and that the 1985 taxes be cancelled. Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion and same carried.

A letter from the North Dakota Association of Counties was read in regards to initiating a local sales tax. Said issue will be discussed further at the annual commissioners convention in November.

The proposal for a new phone system in Sargent County was discussed. Commissioner Manikowski moved that the county purchase a Toshiba Strata XII Electronic Key Service Unit. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

The North Dakota Centennial Commission requested the county board to appoint a County Centennial Committee to represent the county at the People's Centennial Planning Conference at Bismarck on October 25 and 26. The Board moved to contact the County Historical Society and ask them to make appointments to said committee.

Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that effective with 1985 county land sales, all purchases made on contract for deed be charged a rate of interest at 9% per annum. Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Manikowski moved to instruct the County Auditor to call for sealed bids on one 1986 law enforcement vehicle. Bids will be opened at 2:30 p.m. on November 19, 1985. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion and same carried.

Derwood Ellestad, road foreman, met with the Board to review bills and discuss road problems. It was noted that dirt work is necessary starting 3 miles east of Havana and then 2 miles. Commissioner Manikowski will do some checking with dirt contractors in the county. A bridge located east of Lake Tewaukon was discussed but no action taken.

Milton McLaen met with the Board to discuss some problems with approaches on the roadsides. There is not enough slope. The Board will investigate the problem.

The Board proceeded to work on budgets for 1986.





The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with Commissioner Johnson absent.

Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved that the minutes be approved as corrected. Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Mag Anderson moved that the Board approve the October payroll in the amount of \$39,196.88. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

The Board proceeded to hold a public hearing on the 1986 proposed budget for Sargent County. Several department officials met with the Board to discuss various line items on their budgets.

Jeffrey Volk, Moore Engineering, Inc., reported on the status of the three bridges that the county had reconstructed. The State and Federal Highway Administration has critiqued the bridges north of Cayuga and Geneseo and presented their evaluation. It was noted by Jeff that when the county maintains these roads, to be especially careful to maintain the crown near these bridges. The Board agreed to send a letter to the road foreman and blademans with said request. Jeff also presented to the Board a file containing pictures of various bridges in the county that are eligible for federal monies. The Board will study these pictures in the near future and compile a priority list of bridges that should be replaced.

Roger Gibbon met with the Board concerning a 1984 and 1985 weed assessment on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -5-132-53. He indicated that they always mow their weeds and this is the only quarter that a weed assessment has been charged. He asked the Board to consider removing this charge because they do mow the roadside. Commissioner Manikowski moved that the Auditor be instructed to remove the 1984 and 1985 weed assessment. Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Johnson arrived at 1:00 p.m.

The Board proceeded to appraise County Lands and City Lots which have been forfeited to the County for nonpayment of taxes and on motion said appraisals were approved in the amounts shown on a list which will be posted at the front door of the Courthouse on November 4, 1985, according to law and the time of hearing objections to the minimum sales price agreed upon was set at 10:00 a.m. on November 5, 1985.

WHEREAS, House Bill 1053, as passed by the 48th Legislative Assembly, requires the governing body to pass a resolution specifically approving such an additional levy;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of Sargent County specifically approved an increase or additional ad valorem levy in the following funds:



The following bills were audited. Commissioner Mag Anderson moved and Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion that all bills be paid. Motion carried unanimously.



The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with all members present.

Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion that the minutes be approved as amended. Motion carried.

Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Mag Anderson seconded the motion to approve the December payroll in the sum of \$37,739.51. Motion carried unanimously.

Several county employees met with the Board to discuss the proposed health insurance plan. There was much concern about having the same coverage as the present. The Board explained that they are striving to get benefits for employees to their best interest. Kim Bjoralt, BC/BS representative for Sargent County arrived at the meeting and reviewed past claim experience and other statistical information. He agreed to do a comparison on the proposed plan versus Blue Cross/Blue Shield and let the Board know what the total premium would be for Sargent County.

A report from Orville Nelson, Tax Director, was presented to the Board. Said report revealed what the 10% decrease in agricultural land did to residential and commercial property in Sargent County for the 1985 tax year.

Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion to approve Beer and Liquor licenses for the year beginning January 1, 1986 and ending December 31, 1986 to the following persons: Jerome Steiner, dba/Crete Bar, Crete, ND and Don Kadoun, dba/Don's Trading Post, Stirum, ND. Motion carried.

Commissioner Manikowski moved and Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion to approve Games of Chance Permit No. 85-11 to St. Mary's Altar Society, Geneseo, ND for Bingo on January 12 & 26, February 9 & 23 and March 9 & 23, 1986. Motion carried.

The Board agreed to lower the price of the County Centennial Plates from \$8.00 to \$5.00. Plates are available and for sale at the office of the County Auditor.

Commissioner H. L. Anderson moved and Commissioner Manikowski seconded the motion that the County Auditor be instructed to call for bids for election supplies and fuel, regular and unleaded gasoline for use during the 1986 calendar year. Bids will be opened February 4, 1986.




The following bills were audited. Commissioner Mag Anderson moved and Commissioner H. L. Anderson seconded the motion to pay all bills. Motion carried unanimously.
