Also that a Census of all the residents of said Territory was made by Arthur E Boyd on the first day of May 1884 the same being verified by his Affidavit and it also appearing that on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1884 notice of the papers and proceedings was duly posted in the post Office and that the survey Map and census of the Territory proposed to be incorporated has been exhibited at the Office of the Register of Deeds of Sargent County for examination in the manner and for the period required by law. all of which having been duly proven and verified by Affidavit to said Petition Attached And it appearing to said board that the law in such case made and provided has been fully complied with it is hereby ordered that the Territory in such petition described to wit Sections 197 Township 132. Range 54 shall with the assent of the qualified voters thereof be an Incorporated Town by the name of Milnor Also ordered that a Meeting of the qualified voters resident in said proposed town be held at Thompsons Hall on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1884 to determine whether such territory shall be an Incorporated Town and the Clerk of such Board shall give notice by posting up the notices required by law and printing the same in the Sargent County Teller
