Whereas at the last session of the Board an order was made calling a meeting of the legal voters of the proposed Town of Milnor on the 30th day of June 1884 to vote for or against the incorporation of said Town and it appearing from the report of Thomas V. Phelps, Jens Pederson and H. H. Boston Inspectors that such a meeting or election was held at the time appointed and was in all respects conducted according to Law that the whole number of persons voting at such meeting was eighty one, that the number voting for incorporation was forty seven and the number voting against incorporation was thirty four, which said statement was verified by the oath of said Inspectors and this board being satisfied of the legality of said Election it is therefore Ordered that said Town has been incorporated by the name of Milnor Sargent County N.D.

Bill

The Bill of Price and Shuman for 1110 feet of lumber at 20^{cts} and 30 pounds of 20 penny nails at 6 cents per pound furnished the County to be used in the bridge over grass Creek in Kingston appropriated at the last meeting of the board amounting to 30.93 was allowed.
