- 4 That we find a numerical index has been commenced and so far as completed seems to be correct but that as yet it covers but little of the records except those transcribed from Ransom County.
- 5 That we have compared the order book and the stubs therein with the registers book of County orders and with the County Commissioners record books and that we find them to be correct with the exceptions of a variance in the case of County order number 289 issued December 9 1884 in favor of L. S. Lander for transcribing records
- 3 That the grantor and grantee index appear to be correct so far as we have examined with a few minor exceptions
