Board met and were called to order by Chairman according to adjournment members all present the returns from White Stone Hill having been received the board proceeded to canvass the vote for Commissioners in dist No 2 and district No 5 in the canvass in district No 2 Randolph Holding received 99 votes and Jens Pederson 138 majority for Jens Pederson 39 votes in the canvass of the returns from district No 5 there were 101 votes cast of which E. W. Barton ^{received 100 votes} was declared duly elected Commissioner from dist No 5

Jens Pederson Commissioner elect from district No 2 and E. W. Barton Commissioner elect from district No 5 were duly qualified to become members of the board of County Commissioners in and for Sargent County Territory of Dakota

Ordered that all Road Supervisors make application to the County Commissioners for all planks &c they may require for culverts road work and repairing

Ordered that a committee of two be appointed to call on Mr. Belding for the purpose of making arrangements for his building for County Offices. Chairman appointed Barton and Herman

Ordered to adjourn for 15 minutes

Meeting called to order by Chairman members all present Committee reported that Mr. Belding would rent the second story of his building for the use of the County Officers for the sum of five hundred dollars per Annum

Ordered that Mr. Belding's offer be accepted

Ordered that the County Auditor make contract with Mr. Belding & Co for the use of his building one year

Ordered that the County Treasurer insure the County Records for thirteen hundred dollars

Motion made and seconded that the resolution presented asking the Judge of the third judicial subdivision to appoint a term of Court to be held in Milnor Carried

Ordered that the Sheriff's goods ordered from G. D. Barnard and Company be returned and order No 534 given for same be destroyed

Ordered that propositions for changing the County Printing to the Huron Chronicle and from the Sargent scribe to the Item be laid on the table

Liquor license of Tilly and Hardman with Geo Gelwicks, S. M. Lockerby and A. Wells as sureties was approved

Motion made and carried that J. C. Lauder be advanced one hundred and twenty five dollars on his bill No 106 for completing Grantee and Grantor index

Board proceeded to Audit Accounts

C. M. Marboe work on highway Milnor road dist \$ 1.00

Ordered that the same be charged to Milnor dist No 2

Board adjourned to 8 A.M. May 13th 1885
