Noxious Weeds No. 1  
 Section  
 Resolution offered as follows: Resolved, That in accordance with an act of the legislature entitled: "An act to prevent the spread of noxious weeds in Dakota Territory". That the occupants of lands within Sargent County be and they are hereby notified and ordered to destroy on or before July 10<sup>th</sup> 1886 all Canada thistle cockle burr and mustard growing on lands occupied by them. And that the overseer of highways within said county destroy all said weeds growing on the public highways within their respective districts and on unoccupied lands on or before July 17<sup>th</sup> 1886 upon which the occupant thereof shall refuse or neglect to destroy said weeds and that such notice be given to said persons by publishing this resolution for two weeks in the Miller Free Press.
