Motion made that there be appointed three county physicians for the term of one year that the County be divided into three districts for said purpose, one district to embrace ranges 53 and 54, one to embrace ranges 55 and 56 and one to embrace ranges 57 and 58. The appointment of the physicians in said districts to commence on the 9th of May next and the salary of each one of the said physicians to be fixed at \$200.00 per year. Provided that the said physicians have to furnish all medicines prescribed by such physician and all surgical attendance necessary and to respond to all calls from the proper officer or officers, and to attend to all consultations necessary for the performance of the duties of said physicians. Motion seconded and carried. As such physicians were appointed for Ranges 53 and 54 H. W. Bradley, for Ranges 55 and 56 J. J. Halloran for Ranges 57 and 58 J. E. Patterson. On motion board adjourned till 8 o'clock April 11th A.M.
