Whereas the last legislature enacted a law authorizing the county commissioners of any county to pay a bounty for the destruction of gophers therefore be it Resolved That the county upon a presentation of a certificate of the township clerk in the civil township and any Justice of the Peace or Notary Public in the unorganized part, containing the number of scalps presented pay a bounty of 2 cents for every scalp so certified to. Said payments to be made in warrants to be drawn on the gopher destruction fund.
