Whereas there exists in our County a large amount of
 destitution owing to the almost total failure of crops in
 our County during the years of 1889 and 1890 and
 Whereas there are large numbers of persons who are
 bona fide settlers and who by reason of such failure of
 crops will be unable to remain in the County and
 cultivate their lands the coming year unless help can
 be afforded by which they can procure cheap fuel and
 feed therefor be it Resolved that the Chairman of the
 Board appoint a committee of three persons to consult with
 the officials of the several Railroad Companies doing business
 in Sargent County, to procure free transportation for fuel and
 feed for the benefit of the drought stricken settlers of our County
 Resolved that we guarantee to the officials granting us any
 such concession on the rates of fuel and feed, that every
 effort will be used by this Board to see that those persons
